In first two rounds his grievance was regarding re-mustering in Army Medical Corps in Musician Trade which ultimately succeeded. This time his grievance is regarding Statutory Complaint dated 30th October 2020 he has preferred under Section 26 of the Army Act 1950 but not decided as yet by the respondents and he apprehends that if the Statutory Complaint is not decided and promotion to the post of Havildar in Army Medical Corps in Musician Trade, which is likely to be filled in January 2022 by holding Meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee, takes place then a Junior may be promoted to the post for no fault on his part as delay in re-mustering in Musician Trade in applicant's case is not due to applicant.</p> <p>Major Tarun V Pillai, on instructions received, submits that applicant's Statutory Complaint has been returned to Army Medical Corps Centre & Collage undecided as it was not submitted through proper channel. He also submits that meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee in the matter of</p>

promotion to the post of Havildar in Musician Trade of Army Medical Corps is to take place in February 2022.

Upon hearing submissions of the parties learned counsel, we are not happy to note that applicant's Statutory Complaint has been returned indisposed due to being not submitted through proper channel. Being a welfare organisation, the Records ought to have decided the complaint within given time without going into technicality that it was not received through proper channel.

In the circumstances when there is very short time left in holding meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee, we feel it appropriate and necessary to direct the respondents to treat the Original Application as Statutory Complaint and decide the same at the earliest, say within six weeks from the date of receipt of copy of Original Application.

Accordingly, the respondents are directed to treat the Original application as Statutory Complaint and decide the same within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy of Original Application by a speaking and reasoned order under intimation to the applicant.

With above directions, Original Application is disposed of finally.
