It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the applicant that representation preferred by the applicant has been disposed off by the respondents during the pendency of Original Application and applicant came to know about it only when Counter Affidavit is filed, therefore, applicant be permitted to challenge the order by which applicant's representation has been rejected.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the respondents has vehemently opposed the prayer saying since the representation preferred by the applicant has been disposed off during the pendency of Original Application which necessitated fresh cause of action, therefore, applicant cannot be permitted to amend prayer clause of the Original Application by adding one more relief.</p> <p>Upon hearing submissions of Ld. Counsel of both sides and after having gone through the facts and circumstances of the case, we find that since representation preferred by the applicant has been disposed of during the pendency of Original Application and applicant wants to challenge the order rejecting his representation which is based on subsequent event, therefore, the same is permissible in law.</p> <p>In the result, amendment application is allowed.</p> <p>Let amendment be incorporated within a week.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the respondents submitted that so far as disability pension and extending the benefit of rounding off is concerned, a letter has been issued on 26.09.2020 for notification of PPO in order to forward the same to the bank concerned for necessary payment.</p> <p>Heard Ld. Counsel for both sides and perused the record.</p> <p>As regards prayers, applicant is already in receipt of service pension as well as disability element @30% for life to be rounded off to 50%. Applicant's grievance is with regard to issue of Discharge Book, Canteen Smart Card and ECHS Card only.</p> <p>Respondents' submissions in this regard is that applicant has been asked to complete certain formalities such as to submit two single and joint passport size photographs, duly attested by the Zila Sainik Welfare Officer concerned, along with personal application to issue Discharge Book as well as Aadhar Card, E. Mail address and Mobile number vide letter dated 03.03.2021. The applicant has also been asked vide letter dated 04.03.2021 to approach nearest station headquarter for applying canteen card and fill online application on ECHS website and suggested to intimate registration number of ECHS application for verification.</p>

In view of above, with the consent Ld. Counsel of both sides, Original Application is finally **disposed off** with direction to respondents to issue Discharge Book, Canteen Smart Card and ECHS Card to the applicant within a period of two months from the date of receipt of documents from the side of applicant.
