He further submitted that applicant's father, namely, Son Pal Singh died on 08.05.2021 due to Covid – 19 infections. He further submitted that applicant being son wants to perform last rituals of his father for which Interim Bail be allowed to him.</p>

As regards Interim bail for performing last rituals of applicant's father, Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of respondents has no objection.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also that applicant being son wants to perform last rituals of his father who died on 08.05.2021 due to Covid-19 infections, we feel it proper to enlarge applicant on Interim Bail for a period of fifteen days from the date of his release.

Let applicant be enlarged on his furnishing personal bond of Rs.50,000/- before the Registrar of this Tribunal for being release on Interim Bail for a period of fifteen days from the date of release.

It is provided that on the expiry of fifteen days period applicant himself shall surrender before the Prison concern where he is detained and shall be taken into custody.

Let a copy of this order be provided to the Ld. Counsel for the applicant as well as Ld. Counsel for the respondents by today itself for compliance.
