This Tribunal has passed order dated 30.09.2019 in O.A. No. 196 of 2019 granting arrears of disability element to the applicant since 1993 in the line with the duplicate PPO issued by PCDA (P) Allahabad alongwith benefit of rounding off from 20% to 50% for life from 1996.

While filing objection to compliance report, it is submitted by the applicant that so many unnecessary documents/affidavits have been asked by the Treasury Office, Balia for further submission to PCDA (P) Allahabad for release of pension.

Today, during the course of hearing, learned counsel for the respondents submitted that applicant is not providing required documents as per letter dated 26.10.2020 and therefore, his pension is not being released for want of documents.

Though, during the course of hearing, Shri Rajeev Tiwari, Accounts Officer, PCDA (P) Allahabad admitted that documents as asked vide letter dated 26.10.2020 are not required for release of pension.

In view of above, Treasury Officer, Balia is directed to withdraw conditions as imposed vide letter dated 26.10.2020 for providing documents and disburse pension to the applicant without any further delay.

The respondents are also directed to comply with the order of this Tribunal and ensure disbursement of pension to the applicant positively.

With the aforesaid directions, Execution Application is disposed of finally.

This recall application alongwith delay condonation application has been filed by the applicant to recall order dated 14.02.2012 passed in O.A. No. 166 of 2011 by this Tribunal.

The order dated 14.02.2011 was passed in proper perspective after hearing both the parties. The contention of learned counsel for the applicant that similar matter is subjudiced before AFT (Principal Bench), New Delhi, hence, the order dated 14.02.2011 passed by this Tribunal may be recalled and the case be kept abated till any decision comes from AFT (PB), New Delhi.

On this, learned counsel for the respondents raised objection and submitted that recall application at this stage is not sustainable and be dismissed.

In view of above, it is directed that there being no certainty about the decision in AGIF cases whether it will be favourable to the applicants or not. Hence, as on today, recall application is premature and is liable to be dismissed.

Accordingly, recall application alongwith delay condonation application is dismissed.

However, applicant shall have an opportunity to seek recall of order dated 14.02.2011, if any favourable decision is passed by the Principal Bench with regard to payment of disability cover benefits in AGIF matters.
