Instant Original Application has been filed with delay of 41 years, 5 months and 18 days, against order dated 18.10.1973 of the respondents by which applicant has been discharged from service.</p> <p>3. Regarding delay, it is submitted by learned counsel for the applicant that applicant was not provided with any documents while being discharged from service and documents were even not provided despite being demanded time and again and notice dated 17.09.2014 sent through counsel. Thus, he submitted that delay in filing of application is not deliberate.</p> <p>4. Respondents have vehemently opposed the above submission on the premise that explanation offered for delay is not sufficient.</p> <p>5. We have gone through averments made in para 11 of affidavit filed in support of delay condonation application and find that apart from sending five representations dated 13.02.2012, 30.04.2012, 18.04.2013, 22.10.2013 and 07.01.2014 and two legal notices dated 17.09.2014 and 18.05.2015 to respondents for providing documents applicant did nothing between a long period from 18.10.1973 (Date of discharge) to 12.02.2012 for redressal of his grievance. In a case of long delay applicant seeking condonation is under legal obligation to offer not only day to day explanation but sufficient explanation also, which applicant has miserably failed, therefore we do not see any reason to condone the delay.</p> <p>6. Counsel for the respondents.</p> <p>Applicant has filed this application seeking modification in order dated 30.09.2016, passed in Original Application No. 239 of 2015, directing respondents to pay disability pension to the applicant from the date of discharge i.e. 12.08.1996 in place of three years prior to date of filing of Original Application.</p> <p>It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the applicant that applicant had filed the Original Application for the grant of disability pension with effect from date of discharge which was allowed, however, respondents were directed to pay the arrears of the same to the applicant from three years prior to the date of filing of the Original Application i.e. 28.05.2014. he further submitted that applicant had disability @20% for a period of two years on the date of discharge, therefore, his entitlement to get disability pension should reckon from the date of discharge and not from three years prior to date of filing of Original Application. Thus, he submitted that order be modified accordingly.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the respondents has vehemently opposed the aforesaid submissions inter alia on the ground that applicant is seeking review of the order in the garb of modification which is not permissible in law. He further submitted that if applicant was aggrieved with the order that disability pension should be allowed to him from the date of discharge in place of three years prior from the date of filing of Original Application, he should have filed a Review Application on time given in statute for that. He further submitted that order passed in Original Application has been implemented in letter and spirit and Execution Application has been dismissed in full and final satisfaction, thereafter, applicant cannot be permitted to seek modification in the order getting applicability of disability pension from the date of discharge.</p>

We have gone through the order dated 30.09.2016 passed in Original Application No. 239 of 2015 and find that while allowing the Original Application for the grant of disability pension for a period of two years from the date of discharge it has been specifically provided that arrears of disability pension would be payable to applicant from three years prior to date of filing of Original Application. The said order has been implemented by the respondents in letter and spirit and Execution Application has been dismissed in full and final satisfaction. In the circumstances, when it has been specifically stated in the order that arrears of disability pension would be payable to the applicant from three years prior to date of filing of Original Application, applicant cannot be allowed to seek modification in the order. We are further of the view that for entitlement from the date of discharge applicant ought to have sought review of the order which admittedly was not done. Therefore, at this stage, applicant cannot be permitted to seek modification in the order after about five years of its passing.

In view of the aforesaid, modification application deserves to be dismissed.

Accordingly, modification application is dismissed.

Applicant had filed Original Application No. 33 of 2011 against his dismissal order from service which was dismissed on merit on 01.02.2017. The Review Application being Review Application No. 06 of 2017 filed against dismissal of Original Application was also dismissed on 01.03.2017 and leave to appeal arising out of Civil Appeal Diary No. 33210 of 2017 was also dismissed on 12.02.2018 by the Hon'ble Apex Court. For this, he has placed reliance on Judgments of Hon'ble Apex Court in Appeal (Civil) 8216 of 2003, Ram Chandra Singh Vs. Savitri Devi and Others, decided on 09.10.2003 and Appeal Civil) 5097-5099 of 2004, A.V. Papayya Sastry &amp; Others Vs. Government of A.P. &amp; Others, decided on 07.03.2007.</p>

5. We have gone through facts averred in recall application as also the Judgment and order in Original Application and Judgments relied upon and we do not find any force in the recall application. We also find that this application being abuse of process of the Court deserves to be dismissed with special cost.

6. Accordingly, recall application is dismissed with cost Rs.25,000/- payable to A.F.T. Bar Association, Lucknow.
