	His further submission is that in the instant Original Application the
	applicant has raised his grievances that his candidature has been rejected vide
	order dated 05.02.2021 for the reasons that he had failed to submit the police
	verification by 31.01.2021 and that when the applicant's application for his
	candidature has been rejected by the impugned order, he cannot be termed as
	complainant for the adjudication regarding service as he is not subject to Army
	Act, 1950. He pleaded for dismissal of the Original Application being not maintainable.
	In reply to above, Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that the
	applicant in pursuance of notification dated 31.08.2018, appeared in selection,
	declared successful in selection for the post of Soldier General Duty and
	submitted all the requisite documents / certificates before respondent No. 3

twice. His further submission is that prior to issuance of impugned order the respondent No. 3 has neither issued any show cause notice nor afforded any opportunity of hearing to produce said verification letter issued by Police Superintendent. He pleaded that since the applicant was selected for the post of Soldier General Duty, he is to be treated as subject to Army Act, 1950. Heard Ld. Counsel of both sides and perused the record. Section 2 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, enumerates the persons, to whom the provisions of the said Act are applicable. It may be reproduced as follows :-"2. Applicability of the Act.- (1) The provisions of this Act shall apply to all persons subject to the Army Act, 1950 (46 of 1950), the Navy Act, 1957 (62 of 1957) and the Air Force Act, 1950 (45 of 1950). This Act shall also apply to retired personnel subject to the Army (2) Act, 1950 (46 of 1950) or the Navy Act, 1957 (62 of 1957) or the Air Force Act, 1950 (45 of 1950), including their dependants, heirs and successors, in so far as it relates to their service matters". Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, in so far as it is relevant for the instant case, is reproduced as under :-"14. Jurisdiction, powers and authority in service matters .- (1) Save as otherwise expressly provided in this Act, the Tribunal shall exercise, on and from the appointed day, all the jurisdiction, powers and authority, exercisable immediately before that day by all courts (except the Supreme Court or a High Court exercising jurisdiction under article 226 and 227 of the Constitution) in relation to all service matters. (2) Subject to the other provisions of this Act, a person aggrieved by an order pertaining to any service matter may make an application to the Tribunal in such form and accompanied by such documents or other evidence and on payment of such fee as may be prescribed. (3) On receipt of an application relating to service matters, the Tribunal shall, if satisfied after due inquiry, as it may deem necessary, that it is fit for adjudication by it, admit such application; but where the Tribunal is not so satisfied, it may dismiss the application after recording its reasons in writing. (4)..... (5) The Tribunal shall decide both questions of law and facts that may be raised before it." The "service matters" as defined in Section 3(o) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, in so far as it is relevant for the instant case, is reproduced as under :-"3(o) "service matters", in relation to the persons subject to the Army Act, 1950 (46 of 1950), the Navy Act, 1957 (62 of 1957) and the Air Force Act, 1950 (45 of 1950), mean all matters relating to the conditions of their service and shall include remuneration (including allowances), pension and other retirement (i) benefits;

(ii) tenure, including commission, appointment, enrolment, probation, confirmation, seniority, training, promotion, reversion, premature retirement, superannuation, termination of service and penal deductions; (iii) summary disposal and trials where the punishment of dismissal is awarded;
(iv) Any other matter, whatsoever,
but shall not include matters relating to
Section 2 of the Army Act, 1950 enumerates the persons, to whom the
provisions of the said Act are applicable. It may be reproduced as follows:
<i>"2. Persons subject to this Act (1) The following persons shall be subject to this Act wherever they may be, namely:-</i>
 (a) officers, junior commissioned officers and warrant officers of the regular army; (b) persons enrolled under this Act; (c) persons belonging to the Indian Reserve Forces; (d) persons belonging to the Indian Supplementary Reserve Forces when called out for service or when carrying out the annual test; (e) officers of the Territorial Army, when doing duty as such officers, and enrolled persons of the said Army when called out or embodied or attached to any regular forces, subject to such adaptations and modifications as may be made in the application of this Act to such persons under sub-section (1) of Section 9 of the Territorial Act, 1948 (56 of 1948); (f) persons holding commissions in the Army in India Reserve of Officers, when ordered on any duty or service for which they are liable as members of such reserve forces; (g) officers appointed to the Indian Regular Reserve of Officers, when ordered on any duty or service for which they are liable as members of such reserve forces; (h) omitted. (i) persons not otherwise subject to military law who, on active service, in camp, or on the march or at any frontier post specified by the Central Government by notification in this behalf, are employed by, or are in the service of, or are followers of, or accompany any portion of, the regular army.
(2) Every person subject to this Act under clauses (a) to (g) of sub- section (1) shall remain so subject until duly retired, discharged, released, removed, dismissed or cashiered from the service."
A person aggrieved by an order pertaining to any service matter, may make an application to the Tribunal in view of Section 14(2) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007. It clearly shows that the Original Application cannot be moved in the Armed Forces Tribunal, unless, the concerned person is aggrieved by an order pertaining to any service matter. The service matter has been defined in Section 3 (o) of the said Act. A bare perusal of the definition of "service matters" indicates that the concerned person must be subject to the Army Act. 1950, the News Act. 1957 or the Air Force Act. 1950, as the same may
Army Act, 1950, the Navy Act, 1957 or the Air Force Act, 1950, as the case may be. Section 2 of the Army Act, 1950, as referred to above, provides about the persons, who are subject to the provisions of the Army Act, 1950. It has not

been disputed by learned Counsel for the applicant that the applicant has not been enrolled as yet under the provisions of the Army Act, 1950. Learned Counsel for the applicant has not been able to show us that the case of the applicant comes within the purview of any of the clauses of section 2 of the Army Act, 1950. Thus, it is clear that the applicant is not subject to the provisions of the Army Act, 1950.

Since the applicant is not subject to the provisions of the Army Act, 1950, he is not entitled to file the Original Application under Section 14 of The Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, in the Armed Forces Tribunal, because, he is not aggrieved by any order pertaining to any service matter. The service matters, as defined above, clearly indicates that it is a condition precedent that the concerned person must be subject to the Army Act, 1950, the Navy Act, 1957 or the Air Force Act, 1950, as the case may be. If the aggrieved person is not subject to the provisions of any of the said Acts, he cannot be said to be aggrieved by any order pertaining to any service matter.

In view of the aforesaid discussion, we are of the considered view that the applicant is not subject to the provisions of the Army Act, 1950, and hence, the instant Original Application for adjudication of controversy involved in the present matter, is not maintainable and cannot be admitted for hearing, and it deserves to be dismissed at the admission stage itself. The objection raised by the Registry, with regard to lack of jurisdiction of this Tribunal, is perfectly valid.

Accordingly, the Original Application No. 350 of 2021, is **dismissed**.

It is made clear that we have not entered into the merits of the case.
