Counsel for the respondents.</p> <p>Instant Original Application has been filed under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 to set aside Principal Controller of Defence Accounts (Pension), Allahabad letter dated 23.05.2019 by means of which consideration for applicant's Mercy Petition dated 25.03.2019 was denied. Applicant has also prayed for direction to the respondents to sympathetically consider applicant's Mercy application dated 25.03.2019 and grant him 75% of pension entitled to a Havildar (Substantive) discharged on completion of 15 years service considering the fact that he had already rendered about 11 years and 8 ½ months service w.e.f. 30.07.1980 to 16.04.1992.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the respondents has raised preliminary objection on the point of maintainability of instant Original Application. He submitted that as earlier the applicant had filed O.A. No. (Nil) of 2017 along with application for condonation of delay (M.A. No. 1058 of 2017) challenging the order of dismissal dated 16.04.1992 and for grant of pension to the applicant. The said application for condonation of delay as well as Original Application was dismissed by this Tribunal vide order dated 16.11.2018. His further submission is that all reliefs flowing from a cause of action can be claimed together in one O.A. and no separate O.A. could be filed in respect of relief from the same cause of action.</p> <p>There is a delay of 28 years, 01 month and 25 days in filing Original Application.</p> <p>Submission of Ld. Counsel for the applicant is that delay in filing Original Application is not deliberate. His further submission is that after order of dismissal being passed against applicant his wife preferred representation to</p>

Chief of the Army Staff by registered post on 19.10.2003, but it was not responded. Thereafter, applicant himself wrote two letters on 13.08.2006 and 10.08.2008 respectively to the respondents for redressal of his grievance, but these letters also were also not responded. Thereafter, applicant could not approach the Tribunal immediately on account of poverty. Thus, his submission is that delay is not deliberate, but for the reasons stated above.

Ld. Counsel for the respondents has vehemently opposed the prayer and has submitted that long delay of more than 28 years has not been properly and satisfactorily explained.

Having heard the submissions of Ld. Counsel of both sides and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we find that instant O.A. being barred under law is not maintainable and is liable to be dismissed as such. We further note that all reliefs flowing from a cause of action can be claimed in one O.A., no separate O.A. could be filed for relief(s) flowing from the same cause of action. The applicant's earlier Original Application No. (Nil) of 2017 along with delay condonation application (M.A. No. 1058 of 2017) was dismissed by this Tribunal vide order dated 16.11.2018. We also observe that after dismissal of the said Original Application the applicant had preferred Mercy Petition dated 25.03.2019, the consideration of which has been denied by the Principal Controller of Defence Accounts (Pension), Allahabad vide order dated 25.05.2019. If the applicant had any grievance from the order passed by this Tribunal, he ought to have filed review/Appeal before the appropriate forum, as the case lies.

We further find that explanation offered by the applicant for delay in filing Original Application is not sufficient. It is settled in law that if any time limit is given for filing application and the same is not filed within that time limit, delay should be explained on day to day basis which applicant has utterly failed to do in the present case.

In the result, we find that delay is not condonable.

Accordingly, Original Application is dismissed on latches as well as being not maintainable.
