Briefly stated facts of the case are that the applicant was enrolled in the 3. Army on 15.05.1995. Before enrolment, the applicant was married and had a son named Vivek Tiwari whose age was one year and six months on 15.05.1995 as declared by the applicant in the nomination forms. Accordingly the same was transcribed in the service documents of the applicant by Depot Coy of ASC Centre (North). After completion of basic training, when the applicant was posted to 509 ASC Bn, he submitted necessary supporting documents viz. Declaration certificate witnessed by two applicants and countersigned by the OC for notifying the names of his two children in his service documents i.e. (i) Mr Sudhir Tiwari, date of birth 24.12.1993 and (ii) Mr Ritesh Tiwari, date of birth 13.01.1996. Accordingly, 16 RR Bn published Part II Order No. 0/0009/013 & 014/1999. The applicant while posted with 633 (I) Tk Tptr Bn had requested for relationship certificate in respect of his son named Sudhir Tiwari vide his unit signal dated 01.03.2011 and the same was issued

vide letter dated 08.03.2011. Mr Sudhir Tiwari participated in a Recruit Rally conducted at ASC Centre (South) in November 2014 and was provisionally selected. On producing Relationship Certificate by the son of the petitioner, it was forwarded to Records by ASC Centre (South) for verification. The Records verified the certificate mentioning the complete family details of the petitioner, then only petitioner came to know that name of one more son Vivek Tiwari is also entered in his service documents. The petitioner objected it and intimated through his unit that name of Vivek Tiwari has erroneously been recorded in his service documents and the same be cancelled. The name of Vivek Tiwari was not cancelled from the service documents of the petitioner as intimated by the respondents on the ground that name of Vivek Tiwari was entered at the time of enrolment on the basis of nomination Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity given by the petitioner himself duly signed by two witnesses, hence it cannot be cancelled being a part of kindered roll.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that at the time of recording list of members of the family, name of one son namely Sudhir Tiwari recorded twice. The petitioner has two sons, first, Ritesh Tiwari and second, Sudhir Tiwari @ Vivek Tiwari. In place of recording two names of sons of the petitioner three names have been recorded treating alias name a separate person, thus the two persons became three. After getting this fact, the petitioner made an application dated 31.08.2015 requesting correction with respect to total numbers and names of his children recorded in service documents. For this, the petitioner was directed to supply necessary affidavit duly sworn and publishing the same in Hindi Newspaper Rastriya Sahara and submitted this affidavit dated 30.06.2015 and paper publication to the department for correction in record i.e. D.O. Part II. The petitioner submitted joint family photographs duly attested by the Mukhiya of Gram Panchayat showing name and date of birth of all persons with relation to said Sudhir Tiwari vide affidavit dated 05.10.2015. The petitioner also submitted copy of Ration Card issued by Block Development Officer, countersigned by Block Supply Officer, Udwant Nagar, District – Bhojpur wherein only four persons 1. Self, 2. Wife Lalita Devi, 3. Sudhir Tiwari – son and 4. Ritesh Tiwari – son have been figured which shows that there is no son having name Vivek Tiwari. On the application of petitioner, the Unit Commanding Officer forwarded a letter dated 13.07.2015 for necessary correction and cancellation of DO Part II Order. For this error, the son of petitioner named Sudhir Tiwari has been selected for appointment in Army but denied his joining though call letter issued on 28.01.2015. The petitioner as well as his son Sudhir Tiwari are suffering due to this error which is curable and for this several applications supported with affidavits have been sent to the respondents but nothing has been done to correct the service record of the petitioner.

- 5. Learned counsel for the petitioner prayed that there are only two sons of the petitioner namely Sudhir Tiwari and Ritesh Tiwari, therefore, respondents be directed to correct service record of the petitioner to avoid further inconvenience and embarrassment to the petitioner and his sons.
- 6. On the other hand, Ld. Counsel for the respondents submitted that petitioner was enrolled in the Army on 15.05.1995. Before enrolment, the petitioner was married and had a son named Vivek Tiwari whose age was one year and six months as declared by the petitioner himself in the nomination forms at Training Centre. Accordingly, the same was transcribed in the service documents of the petitioner by Depot Coy of ASC Centre (North). When the petitioner was posted to 509 ASC Bn, he submitted necessary supporting documents viz. Declaration certificate witnessed by two persons and countersigned by the OC for notifying the names of his two children in his service documents i.e. (i) Mr Sudhir Tiwari, date of birth 24.12.1993 and (ii) Mr Ritesh Tiwari, date of birth 13.01.1996. Accordingly, 16 RR Bn published Part II Order No. 0/0009/013 & 014/1999. The petitioner while posted with 633 (I) Tk Tptr Bn had requested for relationship certificate in respect of his son named Sudhir Tiwari vide his unit signal dated 01.03.2011 and the same was issued vide letter dated 08.03.2011. Mr Sudhir Tiwari participated in a Recruit Rally conducted at ASC Centre (South) in November 2014 and was provisionally selected. On producing Relationship Certificate by the son of petitioner, it was forwarded to Records by ASC Centre (South) for verification. The Records verified the certificate mentioning the complete family details of the petitioner. Thereafter, petitioner came to know that name of one more son Vivek Tiwari is also entered in his service documents. The petitioner objected it and intimated through his unit that name of Vivek Tiwari has erroneously been recorded in his service documents and the same be cancelled. The name of Vivek Tiwari was not cancelled from the service documents of the applicant on the ground that name of Vivek Tiwari was entered at the time of enrolment on the basis of nomination Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity given by the petitioner himself duly signed by two witnesses, hence name of a family member, once recorded cannot be cancelled being a part of kindered roll. He submitted that O.A. lacks merit and same may be dismissed.
- 7. After perusal of material on record, we are of the opinion that petitioner has only two sons named Sudhir Tiwari and Ritesh Tiwari. Sudhir Tiwari @ Vivek Tiwari is one and same person, not two persons. Hence, Service record of the petitioner needs to be corrected showing only two sons Sudhir Tiwari and Ritesh Tiwari.
- 8. In view of above, the Original Application is allowed. Impugned orders are set aside. The respondents are directed to correct/update service record of

the petitioner showing name of two sons i.e. Mr. Sudhir Tiwari and Mr. Ritesh Tiwari in the details of family members of the petitioner by way of publishing fresh Part II Order and thereafter, issue/provide an updated service record to the petitioner. The entire exercise shall be completed at earliest, preferably within four months from the date certified copy of order is produced to the respondents.

- 9. There shall be no order as to costs.
- 10. Misc. Application, if any, pending for disposal, shall be treated to have been disposed of.
