Upon being mentioned by Shri Manoj Kumar Awasthi, learned counsel, the case was taken up today for hearing.</p> <p>2. Heard Shri Manoj Kumar Awasthi, learned counsel for the applicant and Mrs Amrita Chakraborty, learned counsel for the respondents.</p> <p>3. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that hearing in O.A. No. 493 of 2019 titled <i>Ex Sep (Clk) Pradip Kumar Singh vs Union of India & Others</i> was done on 16.02.2021 through video conferencing and application was orally allowed at the time of hearing. However, on receiving certified copy of the order it appeared that O.A. has been dismissed.</p> <p>4. Mrs Amrita Chakraborty, learned counsel for the respondents fairly admitted that in hearing done through video conference on 16.02.2021 the O.A. was orally allowed but subsequently when order was transcribed and uploaded in site of the Tribunal the O.A. was dismissed which possibly might be due to inadvertence.</p> <p>5. We have gone through the record and we notice that O.A. was heard in Court on 16.02.2021 through video conference and was orally allowed also, but subsequently the order of dismissal of the same date was inadvertently transcribed which possibly might be due to slip of mind and needs to be corrected.</p> <p>6.
