This is an application for condonation of delay in moving the application under section 31(2) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007 for grant of leave to appeal against the judgment and order dated 17.04.2018, passed by this Court in O.A. No. 83 of 2018

This application has been filed by the applicant after a period of limitation. As per stamp reporter's report, there is delay of 03 months & 03 days in filing the application for leave to appeal. Section 31 (2) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007 provides that the application for leave to appeal shall be made for approaching Hon'ble Supreme Court within a period of 30 days beginning with the date of decision of the Tribunal. Apart from it, we have also gone through the grounds and reasons indicated in the affidavit filed in support of the application. In our considered opinion, the grounds urged in support of the prayer for condoning the delay are general in nature and do not appear to be germane in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Office of the Chief Post Master General and others vs Living Media India Ltd and another reported in 2012 STPL (LE) 46200 SC in which the Hon'ble Supreme Court has observed as under:

> "Condonation of delay is an exception and should not be used as an anticipated benefit for government departments" and since "the claim on account of impersonal machinery and inherited bureaucratic methodology of making several notes cannot be accepted in view of the modern technologies being used and available. The law of limitation undoubtedly

binds everybody including the Government."

The Hon'ble Supreme Court further observed as under:

"Since the person(s) concerned were well aware or conversant with the issues involved including the prescribed period of limitationThey cannot claim that they have a separate period of limitation when the Department was possessed with competent persons familiar with court proceedings".

In view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the aforesaid case, the application for condonation of delay cannot be entertained and it is hereby rejected.

M.A. No 1523 of 2018

This is an application under section 31 (1) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007 for grant of leave to appeal, having been moved by the petitioner beyond the period of 30 days. Since the application for condonation of delay in moving this application has been rejected, in consequence thereof, this application is also liable to be rejected.

Even otherwise also, we do not find any point of law of general public importance involved in the decision so as to grant leave to appeal. Accordingly, this application is also **rejected**.

- 5. The aforementioned letter is the impugned order in the present O.A. It does not in any manner affects the rights of the applicant. Simply because the title given "DISCH OF LMC PERS" does not mean that the applicant has been discharged. The applicant has only been referred for specialist opinion. Virtually the submission of the learned counsel for the applicant makes it clear that he apprehends that the applicant may be discharged, however, admittedly there is no specific order of discharge till date.
- 6. We find substance in the submission of the learned counsel for the respondents that this O.A. is premature because by the impugned order the applicant has been referred to specialist opinion only. What would be the opinion of the specialist is only a speculation at this stage. Even if it is presumed that the applicant being in low medical category, is under the process of discharge, even then at this stage, we do not find any ground sufficient to interfere in the matter, because the medical examination of the applicant and the specialist opinion is still awaited. Any decision by the competent authority can be taken in view of the specialist opinion. Therefore, we do not feel it appropriate to interfere in the process of the medical examination of the applicant for the purpose of taking a decision for his retention in Army. At this stage, by the impugned order no decision has been taken by the competent authority affecting the rights of the applicant. Therefore, we are of the view that this O.A. is premature.
- 7. Accordingly, this O.A. is dismissed as premature.

- 1. This is an application for grant of leave to appeal under Section 31 of the Armed Forces Act, 2007 filed by the petitioner.
- 2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in Para 2 of the application for grant of leave to appeal, he has mentioned the grounds on the basis of which he is pressing his prayer for grant of leave of appeal. The said grounds reads as under:

"(i).....

- (a) The order of recording the summary of evidence under Rule 22 of the Army rules, 1954 had been passed by the Commanding Officer of the appellant/accused on the directions of the Brigade Commander and not by the Commanding Officer by applying his own mind to the facts and circumstances of the case.
- (b) The order for trying the appellant/accused on the charge of 'murder' had been passed in writing by the Brigade Commander who had no power or authority to pass such order, but the same was binding on the Commanding Officer of the appellant/accused, as the said Brigade Commander was the immediate superior officer of the Commanding Officer.
- (c) The Conveying Authority, without applying its mind to the provisions of Rule 37 of the Army Rules, 1954; ordered the trial of the appellant/accused on the charge of 'murder' whereas the court of inquiry and the summary of evidence which had been sent to him alongwith the application for convening the General Court Martial (GCM) clearly indicated that the firing which took place from the service rifle of the appellant/accused, was purely accidental and the death of L/NK Laxman Prasad and the injuries sustained by the appellant/accused, had been declared to be attributable to military service in the Counter Insurgency Operations (CI Ops).
- (d) The DJAG at HQ 16 Corps had been directed by the superior authorities to assist the Commanding Officer and the General

Court Martial to secure the conviction of the appellant/accused on the charge of 'murder.'

(ii)....."

3. Learned counsel for the respondents has argued that the grounds taken by the learned counsel for the applicant for leave to appeal, cannot be considered to be sufficient ground in view of the language of Section 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 for grant of leave to appeal. Section 31 of the AFT Act reads as under:

"31. Leave to appeal. —

- (1) An appeal to the Supreme Court shall lie with the leave of the Tribunal; and such leave shall not be granted unless it is certified by the Tribunal that a point of law of general public importance is involved in the decision, or it appears to the Supreme Court that the point is one which ought to be considered by that Court.
- (2) An application to the Tribunal for leave to appeal to the Supreme Court shall be made within a period of thirty days beginning with the date of the decision of the Tribunal and an application to the Supreme Court for leave shall be made within a period of thirty days beginning with the date on which the application for leave is refused by the Tribunal.
- (3) An appeal shall be treated as pending until any application for leave to appeal is disposed of and if leave to appeal is granted, until the appeal is disposed of; and an application for leave to appeal shall be treated as disposed of at the expiration of the time within which it might have been made, but it is not made within that time."
- 4. A bare perusal of the aforesaid section makes it clear that in order to grant leave to appeal, a point of law of "general public importance" must be involved. All the grounds that have been mentioned by the learned counsel for the petitioner in his application for grant of leave to appeal, are grounds specifically relating to the case of the individual and cannot be termed, by any stretch of imagination, to be of public importance. Therefore, we do not find it sufficient to grant leave to appeal.
- 5. Accordingly, the application for grant of leave to appeal is hereby rejected.
