5. The aforementioned letter is the impugned order in the present O.A. It does not in any manner affects the rights of the applicant. Simply because the title given “**DISCH OF LMC PERS**” does not mean that the applicant has been discharged. The applicant has only been referred for specialist opinion. Virtually the submission of the learned counsel for the applicant makes it clear that he apprehends that the applicant may be discharged, however, admittedly there is no specific order of discharge till date.

6. We find substance in the submission of the learned counsel for the respondents that this O.A. is premature because by the impugned order the applicant has been referred to specialist opinion only. What would be the opinion of the specialist is only a speculation at this stage. Even if it is presumed that the applicant being in low medical category, is under the process of discharge, even then at this stage, we do not find any ground sufficient to interfere in the matter, because the medical examination of the applicant and the specialist opinion is still awaited. Any decision by the competent authority can be taken in view of the specialist opinion. Therefore, we do not feel it appropriate to interfere in the process of the medical examination of the applicant for the purpose of taking a decision for his retention in Army. At this stage, by the impugned order no decision has been taken by the competent authority affecting the rights of the applicant. Therefore, we are of the view that this O.A. is premature.

7. Accordingly, this O.A. is dismissed as premature.

Leave to appeal. —</p> <p><i>(1) An appeal to the Supreme Court shall lie with the leave of the Tribunal; and such leave shall not be granted unless it is certified by the Tribunal that a point of law of general public importance is involved in the decision, or it appears to the Supreme Court that the point is one which ought to be considered by that Court.</i></p> <p><i>(2) An application to the Tribunal for leave to appeal to the Supreme Court shall be made within a period of thirty days beginning with the date of the decision of the Tribunal and an application to the Supreme Court for leave shall be made within a period of thirty days beginning with the date on which the application for leave is refused by the Tribunal.</i></p> <p><i>(3) An appeal shall be treated as pending until any application for leave to appeal is disposed of and if leave to appeal is granted, until the appeal is disposed of; and an application for leave to appeal shall be treated as disposed of at the expiration of the time within which it might have been made, but it is not made within that time.”</i></p> <p>4. A bare perusal of the aforesaid section makes it clear that in order to grant leave to appeal, a point of law of “general public importance” must be involved.
