Section 31 (2) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007 provides that the application for leave to appeal shall be made for approaching Hon'ble Supreme Court within a period of 30 days beginning with the date of decision of the Tribunal.</p> <p>In view of this, the application for condonation of delay cannot be entertained and it is hereby rejected.</p> <p><u>M.A. No 1985 of 2018</u></p> <p>This application for grant of leave to appeal, having been moved by the applicant-respondents beyond the statutory period of 30 days. Since the application for condonation of delay in moving this application has been rejected, in consequence thereof, this application is also liable to be rejected.</p>
