The respondents are also directed to submit a detailed time line of what was the role and actions of record office in executing the order dated 09.10.2015 and on what basis it is being claimed that record office has completed all its actions and PCDA is to be blamed for delay.”</i></p> <p>Today learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that it is only the PCDA (SC), Pune, who is responsible for causing the delay in compliance of the order under execution, because the claim of the applicant was processed by the PAO, Armored Corps, Ahmadnagar and was forwarded to the PCDA (SC), Pune in the year 2017, but inspite of several reminders, the PCDA (SC), Pune is not complying with the order.
