No. 655 of 2017.</p> <p>As per stamp reporter's report, there is delay of 01 month and 16 days in filing the application for leave to appeal. Section 31 (2) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007 provides that the application for leave to appeal <u>shall</u> be made for approaching Hon'ble Supreme Court within a period of 30 days beginning with the date of decision of the Tribunal. Apart from it, we have also gone through the grounds and reasons indicated in the affidavit filed in support of the application. In our considered opinion, the grounds urged in support of the prayer for grant of leave to appeal do not appear to be germane in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Office of the Chief Post Master General and others vs Living Media India Ltd and another reported in 2012 STPL (LE) 46200 SC in which the Hon'ble Supreme Court has observed as under:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>“Condonation of delay is an exception and should not be used as an anticipated benefit for government departments” and since “the claim on account of impersonal machinery and inherited bureaucratic methodology of making several notes cannot be accepted in view of the modern technologies being used and available. The law of limitation undoubtedly</i></p>

*binds everybody including the Government.”*

The Hon’ble Supreme Court further observed as under :

*“Since the person(s) concerned were well aware or conversant with the issues involved including the prescribed period of limitation .....They cannot claim that they have a separate period of limitation when the Department was possessed with competent persons familiar with court proceedings”.*

In view of the decision of the Hon’ble Supreme Court in the aforesaid case, the application for condonation of delay cannot be entertained and it is hereby rejected.

**M.A. No 1006 of 2018**

This is an application under section 31 (1) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007 for grant of leave to appeal, having been moved by the applicant beyond the period of 30 days. Since the application for condonation of delay in moving this application has been rejected, in consequence thereof, this application is also liable to be rejected.

Even otherwise also we do not find any point of law of general public importance involved in the decision so as to grant leave to appeal. Accordingly, this application is also rejected.

No. 42 of 2018.</p> <p>As per stamp reporter's report, there is delay of 01 month and 23 days in filing the application for leave to appeal. Section 31 (2) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007 provides that the application for leave to appeal <u>shall</u> be made for approaching Hon'ble Supreme Court within a period of 30 days beginning with the date of decision of the Tribunal. Apart from it, we have also gone through the grounds and reasons indicated in the affidavit filed in support of the application. In our considered opinion, the grounds urged in support of the prayer for grant of leave to appeal do not appear to be germane in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Office of the Chief Post Master General and others vs Living Media India Ltd and another reported in 2012 STPL (LE) 46200 SC in which the Hon'ble Supreme Court has observed as under:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>“Condonation of delay is an exception and should not be used as an anticipated benefit for government departments” and since “the claim on account of impersonal machinery and inherited bureaucratic methodology of making several notes cannot be accepted in view of the modern technologies being used and available. The law of limitation undoubtedly binds everybody including the Government.”</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>The Hon'ble Supreme Court further observed as under :</i></p>

*“Since the person(s) concerned were well aware or conversant with the issues involved including the prescribed period of limitation .....They cannot claim that they have a separate period of limitation when the Department was possessed with competent persons familiar with court proceedings”.*

In view of the decision of the Hon’ble Supreme Court in the aforesaid case, the application for condonation of delay cannot be entertained and it is hereby rejected.

**M.A.No. 992 of 2018**

This is an application under section 31 (1) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007 for grant of leave to appeal, having been moved by the applicant beyond the period of 30 days. Since the application for condonation of delay in moving this application has been rejected, in consequence thereof, this application is also liable to be rejected.

Even otherwise also, we find that the matter pertains to release the enhanced service pension in the rank of Naib Subedar w.e.f. 01.01.2006 but we do not find any point of law of general public importance involved in the decision so as to grant leave to appeal. Accordingly, this application is also rejected.

No. 137 of 2014.</b></p> <p><b>By the order under execution, the applicant was to be reinstated in service, however, regarding recovery of pension amount for the period of his long absence due to which he was presumed to be dead, the recovery was stayed. The O.A. was decided in terms of the order passed in the case State of Punjab &amp; Ors vs Rafiq Masih (White Washer) (2014 (8) SCC 883), wherein the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Para 12 held as under :</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>“12. It is not possible to postulate all situations of hardship, which would govern employees on the issue of recovery, where payments have mistakenly been made by the employer, in excess of their entitlement. Be that as it may, based on the decisions referred to herein above, we may, as a ready reference, summarise the following few situations, wherein recoveries by the employers, would be impermissible in law:</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>(i) Recovery from employees belonging to Class-III and Class-IV service (or Group 'C' and Group 'D' service).</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>(ii) Recovery from retired employees, or employees who are due to retire within one year, of the order of recovery.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>(iii) Recovery from employees, when the excess payment has been made for a period in excess of five years, before the order of recovery is issued.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>(iv) Recovery in cases where an employee has wrongfully been required to discharge duties of a higher post, and has been paid accordingly, even though he should have rightfully been required to work against an inferior post.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>(v) In any other case, where the Court arrives at the conclusion, that recovery if made from the employee, would be iniquitous or harsh or arbitrary to such an extent, as would far outweigh the equitable balance of the employer's right to recover.”</i></p> <p><b>Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that in pursuance of</b></p>

the said order, the applicant has joined the service, but his back wages have not been paid.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that prior to this Execution Application, Execution Application No.56 of 2017 was filed by the applicant for the execution of the said order, which was disposed of finally. As the order under execution has been complied with, therefore, this Second Execution Application for the same cause of action is not maintainable. If the applicant is aggrieved by the non payment of back wages, then it is a fresh cause of action as there was no direction for payment of back wages.

Learned counsel for the applicant has argued that during the hearing of O.A.No. 137 of 2017 on 25<sup>th</sup> April 2016, the Tribunal passed an order. Our attention has been drawn towards following part of the said order :

*“Since the applicant has prayed for his joining with complete back wages, it is to be seen as to whether the applicant, who himself admits in the petition that he had lost his mental balance and was admitted in Doon Hospital for treatment, is medically fit to join his duties.”*

It is submitted that in the order under execution, it is mentioned that in pursuance of the order dated 25<sup>th</sup> April 2016, the applicant was medically examined at Doon Hospital. In the opinion of the Medical Board, the applicant was found to be fit. Thus, on the basis of the aforementioned part of order, learned counsel for the applicant has argued that the applicant is also entitled to back wages. There is no dispute to the fact situation that there is no specific direction for payment of the back wages in the order under execution. It is only on the basis of an inference, learned counsel for the applicant has pressed this execution application for payment of back wages.

The scope of an execution application is very limited and the executing court is restricted only to the directions given by the Tribunal in the order under execution.

Before proceeding further, we would like to consider the legal aspect regarding the power and scope of executing court. In the case of Rameshwar Dass Gupta vs. State of U.P. Another (AIR 1997 Sc 410), the Hon’ble Supreme Court held in Para 4 as under :

*“It is well settled legal position that an executing Court cannot travel beyond the order or decree under execution, It gets jurisdiction only to execute the order in accordance with the procedure laid down under Order 21, CPC. In view of the fact that it is a money claim, what was to be computed is the arrears of the salary, gratuity and pension after computation of his promotional benefits in accordance with the service law. That having been done and the court having decided the entitlement of the decree-holder in a sum of*

*Rs.1,97,000/- and odd, the question that arises is whether the executing Court could step out and grant a decree for interest which was not part of the decree for execution on the ground of delay in payment or for unreasonable stand taken in execution ? In our view, the executing Court has exceeded its jurisdiction and the order is one without jurisdiction and is thereby a void order. It true that the High Court normally exercises its revisional jurisdiction under Section 115, CPC but once it is held that the executing Court has exceeded its jurisdiction, it is but the duty of the High Court to correct the same. Therefore, we do not find any illegality in the order passed by the High Court in interfering with and setting aside the order directing payment of interest.”*

In another case, Hon’ble Supreme Court in the case of Shivshankar Gurgar vs. Dilip (AIR 2014 SC 1182) held in Para 13.2 as under :

*“13.2. In our opinion, the order dated 23.11.2005 virtually amounts to the modification of the decree and is without jurisdiction on the part of the executing court, therefore, a nullity. It is a settled principle of law that the executing court cannot go beyond the decree. It has no jurisdiction to modify a decree. It must execute the decree as it is. This Court in [Deepa Bhargava and Another v. Mahesh Bhargava and Others](#) [(2009) 2 SCC 294] held thus:-*

*“9. There is no doubt or dispute as regards interpretation or application of the said consent terms. It is also not in dispute that the respondent judgment-debtors did not act in terms thereof. An executing court, it is well known, cannot go behind the decree. It has no jurisdiction to modify a decree. It must execute the decree as it is....”*

We have examined the judgment under execution carefully and we found that there is no specific direction that the back wages for the period of his absence be paid to the applicant. Therefore, simply on the basis that the applicant was medically examined subsequently, an inference should be drawn that there was a direction of the Tribunal for payment of back wages.

As per the facts of this case, the applicant was missing since 09.04.2005 and when he was medically examined on 25<sup>th</sup> April 2016, the Medical Board reported him to be fit and therefore, the Tribunal directed as above.

It transpires from perusal of the record that after his missing, the applicant was presumed to be dead, because of his long absence. Thereafter the pension was being paid to the next of kin. However the

same was returned under changed circumstance and by the order under execution, the respondents were directed not to recover the interest on the said amount or make any other recovery. The applicant submits that the applicant should be paid back wages for the said period of his absence. Admittedly, there was no specific direction for the payment of back wages for the period of his long absence and no such presumption can be drawn, while dealing with an application for execution. The applicant is not entitled to any further relief in this second Execution Application. If the applicant is aggrieved by non payment of back wages for the period of his absence, then that may be a separate cause of action, for which no order can be passed in this second Execution Application.

Accordingly, this application for execution is misconceived, deserves to be dismissed and is hereby dismissed.
