It is submitted that the order of dismissal of Misc. C.A. for want of prosecution passed by the District Judge, SC/ST Act, Farrukhabad was without jurisdiction because after coming into force the Armed Forces Tribunal, Act, 2007 there is no power to adjudicate the service matters of the persons subject to Army Act, Navy Act and Ari Force Act by the District Court. The perusal of the record of said Misc. Appeal shows that on 18.12.2014 the Court concerned was informed that the Armed Forces Tribunal has come into existence, therefore, this case has to be transferred to the Armed Forces Tribunal, but no order was passed on this application. Several dates were fixed on the said application. On 07.12.2015 since none responded to call, therefore, the case was dismissed in default of appellant. At this stage we would like to reproduce Section 34 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, which reads as under :-</p> <p><i>"34. Transfer of pending cases : (1) Every suit, or other proceeding pending before any court including a High Court or other authority immediately before the date of establishment of the Tribunal under this Act, being a suit or proceeding the cause of action whereon it is based, is such that it would have been within</i></p>

the jurisdiction of the Tribunal, if it had arisen after such establishment within the jurisdiction of such Tribunal, stand transferred on that date to such Tribunal.

(2) Where any suit, or other proceeding stands transferred from any court including a High Court or other authority to the Tribunal under sub-section (1),—

(a) the court or other authority shall, as soon as may be, after such transfer, forward the records of such suit, or other proceeding to the Tribunal;

(b) the Tribunal may, on receipt of such records, proceed to deal with such suit, or other proceeding, so far as may be, in the same' manner as in the case of an application made under sub-section (2) of section 14, from the stage which was reached before such transfer or from any earlier stage or de novo as the Tribunal may deem fit."

After establishment of the Armed Forces Tribunal and particularly keeping in view of fact that when this point was informed to the Court concerned, there was no occasion for the Court to dismiss the Appeal for want of prosecution. The said order is without jurisdiction. Accordingly, it is set aside. Misc. Appeal No. 166 of 2006 is restored to its original number.
