No. 98 of 2016.</p> <p>This application has been filed by the applicant-respondents after expiry of the period of limitation. As per office report, there is delay of 01 year, 02 months & 13 days in filing the application for leave to appeal. As per office report, there is delay of 02 days in filing the application for leave to appeal.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the applicant has pointed out that following question of law of general public importance is involved to grant leave to appeal :-</p> <p><i>“Whether a death or injury suffered by service personnel in a road accident in civil area while being in duty station and living normal life would amount to attributable to military service or not.”</i></p> <p>This point has already been adjudicated by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of <i>Union of India & Others vs. Ex Naik Vijay Kumar</i> (Civil Appeal No. 6583 of 2015 arising out of CAD No. 13923 of 2014 decided on 26.08.2015) that</p>

there must be some causal connection with army duty and the case has been decided following the pronouncement of Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of Ex Naik Vijay Kumar (supra). Since the point of law is settled, there is no question to grant leave to appeal.

Accordingly, application for leave to appeal is rejected on the ground of delay as well as on merits.
