No. 46 of 2016.</p> <p>By means of the present petition, the petitioner has made the following prayer:-</p> <p><i>“(a) Issue a writ in the nature and direction of Certiorari to quash the impugned order of moment dated 9.6.2002 and order dated 27.12.2002 (Annexure No 2 and 5). (b) Issue any other and suitable order or direction as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case. (c) Award the cost of petition in favour of the petitioner.”</i></p> <p>A perusal of the petition shows that the petitioner was posted in RM Platoon 1/9 GRK of 56 APO. During the year 2002 the petitioner was granted part of annual leave with effect from 03.03.2002 to 01.04.2002. However, the petitioner did not report for duty after expiry of leave nor any information was received from him in the unit. The petitioner voluntarily report at 213 Transit Camp on 02.06.2002. On 09.06.2002 the petitioner was issued movement order to proceed to his parent unit. During course of hearing of the T.A. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has admitted that in pursuance to said movement order the</p>

petitioner had joined at the place of his posting and thereafter an inquiry was conducted and he was dismissed from service being a deserter.

Thus, the order which the petitioner has prayed to be quashed in the petition i.e. the movement order has already been complied with and therefore there is no occasion for this Tribunal to interfere with the same.

Apart from it Section 3 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 places an embargo on the Tribunal to entertain matters which are not covered within the scope of 'service matters'. The said provision is incorporated as under:-

“(3) (o) (iv) (ii) but shall not include-Transfers and postings including the change of place or unit on posting whether individually or as a part of a unit, formation or ship in relation to the persons subject to the Army Act, 1950 (46 of 1950), The Navy Act, 1957 (62 of 1957) and the Air Force Act, 1950 (45 of 1950).

Thus keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner for quashing of the movement order, which as per admission of Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has already been complied with, and that too after 15 years, we do not consider it appropriate to enter into the controversy.

The T.A. deserves to be dismissed and is hereby dismissed.
