Cost of Rs. 20,000/- was also imposed in case the compliance report is not filed. Thereafter, the case was listed on 24.12.2018, but on the same day, the Bench was not available.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Today, when the case is taken up, there is no progress in the matter and again adjournment is prayed. It shows the negligent approach of the respondents in complying with the order. Counsel for the respondents.</p> <p>In this case the prayer of the applicant is that the respondents be directed to take the applicant on strength by allowing him to join Artillery Centre, Hyderabad and to allow the applicant to be taken under Military Custody by Central Command Military Police Unit.</p> <p>The Ld. Counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant was declared deserter, but, before expiry of the statutory period of three years he has come before this Tribunal and therefore, the respondents are in obligation to take him on strength. They may take disciplinary action according to law.</p> <p>The Ld. Counsel for the respondents has produced before us the letter dated 02.04.2019 for perusal. Para 3 of the said letter reads as under:-</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><i>“3. As per Para 4 of IHQ of MoD (Army) letter No A/20314/MT3 dated 28 Feb 1986 (copy att), a recruit who become absent without leave for a period of 30 consecutive days during Basic Military Training period will not be allowed to rejoin his training again. Such recruits will be discharged after necessary disciplinary action and under the provisions contained in Amy Act Section 20(3) read in conjunction with Para 22 of Army Order 43/2001/DV (copy att). In addition, an Army personal, who has deserted the Army from a peace area and has not reported even after three years of desertion, will be dismissed from service. In the instant case, the applicant has not completed three years of his desertion and on this</i></p>

*continuous desertion he will be dismissed from service with effect from 08 Jan 2020, i.e. after completion of three years of desertion period if he fails to rejoin duty.”*

Thus admittedly period of three years has not elapsed after desertion and the applicant has not yet been dismissed from service.

In view of above, respondents are directed to take the applicant on strength. The respondents are free to take disciplinary action against the applicant by following due procedure of law.

The applicant is directed to report to his Unit within a period of one month from today positively.

Let a copy of this order be provided to the Ld. Counsel for both the parties and also to the applicant within twenty four hours for compliance.

With the aforesaid direction the **Original Application No. 563 of 2017** stands finally **disposed off**.
