Today it is submitted on behalf of the respondents that details of the bank account, Adhar Card and PAN card of applicant were required by the respondents and the same has not yet been submitted by the applicant. At this point, learned counsel for the applicant interjected and submitted that the applicant has not received any such request from the respondents. Additionally he submitted that the applicant is already receiving pension, hence the necessary details are in PPO and with the respondents. On our query that this is a case of execution of judgment dated 31.01.2018, hence why the respondents have not completed the required paper action in last over one year and what is their SOP on timely implementation of judicial orders, the respondents had no clear answer. We also asked them for evidence as to how and when the respondents have communicated with the applicant for submission of additional documents, however, the respondents had no clear information in this matter.

In view of the above, it appears to us that the respondents are not serious about execution of the order.

It was further submitted by the respondents that the cost imposed earlier shall be deposited within a short period.

List this case on 17.05.2019 for filing compliance report, failing which the respondents will have to deposit cost of Rs.30,000/- in the Registry, which shall be paid to the applicant through cheque. The respondents are free to realize the same from the erring official/officer responsible for delay in execution of the order after holding an enquiry.
