No.33 of 2011 was dismissed vide order dated 01.02.2017. Thereafter the applicant's first Review Application was also rejected on 01.03.2017. Against the said order of rejection dated 01.03.2017, the applicant preferred LTA before the Hon'ble Apex Court with DY No.33310 of 2017 and the Hon'ble Apex Court after condoning the delay, rejected the LTA and also dismissed the appeal. Even after rejection of the LTA by the Hon'ble Apex Court, second Review Application was moved by the applicant which was rejected by this Tribunal on 01.04.2019. Since the applicant moved repeated Review Application without any substance, therefore, the Tribunal imposed a cost of Rs.10,000/- on the review applicant and exemption application was also rejected by the Tribunal.</p> <p>We fail to understand as to why learned counsel for the applicant has taken such steps when the case of the applicant stands finalized by the Hon'ble Apex Court. Moving of such applications without any substance amounts to abuse of process of court and also wastage of precious time of the Tribunal. Therefore, we are compelled to dismiss the application for Leave to Appeal with cost of Rs.15,000/-, which shall be paid within one month from today and if the same is not paid, the same shall be recovered as arrears of land revenue.
