Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that applicant is getting disability pension from the opposite parties vide PPO dated 16.06.2007. The applicant had preferred several applications to the opposite parties for publication of Part II Order of the family members, issue of ECHS Card, CSD Canteen card and fresh discharge book entering the name of the family members of the applicant but respondents had denied the request stating that nothing can be done in this connection, vide their letters dated 03.04.2018 and 09.01.2019. He also submitted that applicant is getting disability pension from the opposite parties being an ex-serviceman and therefore, action on the part of the opposite parties is violative of Articles 14, 16 & 21 of the Constitution of India. He pleaded for issue of ECHS Card, CSD Canteen card and fresh discharge book with the name of the family members of the applicant.

Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that applicant has been granted disability pension w.e.f. 16.06.2007 vide PPO dated 07.02.2017. The applicant had requested Signals Records for publication of marriage Part II Order through Zila Sainik Kalyan Evam Punarvas, Varanasi which was published vide order dated 19.04.2018. The applicant has never requested or sent any application to the respondents for issue of ECHS card, CSD Card, New Discharge Book and amended PPO.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the respondents also submitted that name of applicant's wife has already been entered/recorded in the PPO but the applicant has never requested or sent any application to the respondents for issue of ECHS card, CSD Card, New Discharge Book and amended PPO. Therefore, applicant is requested to :

- (a) Apply online through official website of ECHS for issue of ECHS card and the same shall be issued by Signals Records.
- (b) For CSD card, applicant has to submit an application to his nearest CSD Canteen/Station Headquarters for issue of Canteen card and the same shall be issued by them.
- (c) For New Discharge Book, applicant needs to approach Zila Sainik Kalyan Evam Punarvas, Varanasi for inclusion of name of his wife in discharge book as intimated to him vide Signals Records letter dated 31.12.2021.

In view of aforesaid discussions/observations, we find that name of applicant's wife has already been entered/recorded in the PPO. Therefore, respondents are directed to issue a fresh Discharge Book to the applicant mentioning the name of wife and family members of the applicant. The respondents are also directed to issue ECHS Card and CSD card to the applicant, if the applicant applies for these cards properly. The respondents shall take appropriate action with regard to issue of aforesaid documents/cards within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the

order or on receipt of required applications/documents from the applicant.

With aforesaid directions, Original Application is **disposed off** finally.

Being aggrieved, the applicant has filed the present Original Application to grant 20% of additional pension on attaining the age of 80 years.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that applicant was enrolled in the Army on 17.01.1961 and was discharged from service on 31.01.1989. The applicant is in receipt of service pension. The date of birth of the applicant is 17.01.1942 and he has completed 80 years of age as on 18.01.2021, therefore, as per rules, applicant is entitled to 20% of additional pension on attaining the age of 80 years but the same has not been released</p>

by the respondents in very illegal and arbitrary manner ignoring the settled position of law. The applicant submitted a representation dated 20.10.2021 but nothing has been done by the opposite parties. He pleaded to grant additional 20% pension to the applicant w.e.f. 18.01.2021 with interest.

Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that respondents in their counter affidavit have mentioned that as per service record the date of birth of the applicant is 17.01.1942 and he will attain 80 years of age on 17.01.2022, therefore, the applicant is presently ineligible for additional pension and Original Application has been filed prematurely. He will however, become eligible for additional pension @ 20% on 18.01.2022 after attaining the age of 80 years. He also submitted that as per Para 12 of Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence letter dated 11.11.2008, additional quantum of pension on attaining the age of 80 years will be paid directly by the PDA as per date of birth recorded in PPO.

In view of above, respondents are directed to ensure payment of 20% additional quantum of pension to the applicant from due date, i.e. 18.01.2022 on attaining the age of 80 years and PDA is directed to release additional quantum of pension in the applicant's account alongwith arrears within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Default will invite interest @ 8% per annum till actual payment.

With aforesaid directions, Original Application is **disposed off** finally.

No order as to costs.

Default will invite interest @ 8% per annum till actual payment.
