Counsel for the respondent – applicant.</p> <p style="text-indent: 40px;">For the reasons stated in affidavit filed in support of modification application, modification application is allowed.</p> <p style="text-indent: 40px;">Para 12 and 13 of the order dated 26.03.2021 are modified/replaced to the following effects, which shall be part of that order :-</p> <p style="text-indent: 40px;">“12. Keeping in view of the facts and circumstances of the case and various policies, we converge to the view that applicant's husband is entitled for consideration for award of Battle Casualty Status, as such applicant is entitled for grant of Liberalized Family Pension.</p> <p style="text-indent: 40px;">13. Accordingly, Original Application succeeds and is allowed. The impugned Order by which the claim for Battle Casualty status of the applicant's husband has been denied is hereby set aside. The respondents are directed to grant Battle Casualty Status to the applicant's husband and Liberalized Family Pension to the applicant from the date of death of her husband. However, due to law of limitations settled by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of <i>Shiv Dass v. Union of India and others [2007 (3) SLR 445]</i>, the arrears of Liberalized Family Pension will be restricted to three years preceding the date of filing of the instant O.A. The date of filing of this O.A. is 27.09.2018. The respondents are further directed to make necessary calculations with regard to deficiency in pension (difference between Liberalized Family Pension and Special Family Pension) so accrued on grant of Liberalized Family Pension (comprising service element and Liberalized Family Pension) and pay the same to the applicant within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
