He has made a prayer that proceedings in the case be stayed till passing of order on the petition pending in the Armed Force Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi.</p> <p>Application cannot be kept pending indefinitely on the premise that a transfer petition is pending in Armed Forces Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi, however, keeping in view of the request made, the applicant is allowed six weeks time to bring the transfer order from the Armed Forces Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi.
