He further submits that earlier the file was submitted to the Office of Principal Integrated Financial Advisor (Army), New Delhi, but it was returned with some objections which were removed and file has been re-submitted on 25.11.2022.</p> <p>This Execution Application has been filed for the implementation of order dated 16.05.2019 in Original Application No. 19 of 2019 by which respondents have been directed to grant disability pension to the applicant @30% for two years and to carry out a fresh Re-Survey Medical Board (RSMB) for the applicant for his second disability i.e. 'Stricture Urethra (Optd) 598' within a period of four months from the date of order.</p> <p>It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the respondents that being aggrieved with the order in execution the respondents had filed a Review Application which was dismissed. Thereafter, they had filed a Leave to Appeal application which was also dismissed. Thereafter, the case of the applicant has</p>

been forwarded for implementation of the order. Thus, he submitted that the delay in implementation of the order is not deliberate but for the reason stated above.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant submitted that order directing the respondents to pay disability pension to the applicant has been passed on 16.05.2019, the same has not been implemented as yet.

Upon hearing submissions of Ld. Counsel of both sides we find that respondents are sitting over the matter since more than three and half years without any cogent reason. When the order was not complied with for about 17 months the Execution Application was filed in September, 2022 and even after the expiration of 19 months from the date of filing of Execution Application when nothing was done in the matter, on 06.10.2022 we granted two weeks time to the respondents on their request to make compliance of the order and also directed that in the event of order being not complied with the officer responsible for implementation of the order shall physical appear in Tribunal on the next date fixed to explain the reason of non-compliance. Despite the same, the officer responsible for implementation of the order did not appear, with the result, we directed the registry of this Tribunal to issue notice to the Director, PS Directorate - 4, IHQ of MoD (Army), New Delhi for his appearance on the next date fixed i.e. today. This order was passed on 11.11.2022. Director, PS Directorate - 4, IHQ of MoD (Army), New Delhi is not present before us to explain the reasons a Major rank officer - Major G.R. Sawant is present on his behalf and he informs that matter is pending with Principal Integrated Financial Advisor (Army), New Delhi for his financial concurrence since 25.11.2022. The explanation offered by the officer is insufficient. We, therefore, direct registry to issue notice to Director, PS Directorate - 4, IHQ of MoD (Army), New Delhi to physically appear before this Tribunal on the next date fixed to explain the reason of non-compliance failing which matter will be seriously viewed.
