Counsel for the applicant submits that as per order dated 07.04.2017 this Tribunal had directed respondents to pay consequential benefits to applicant along with interest at the normal rate, however, in the PPO generated in compliance of the order there was no mention of interest with the result nothing has been paid to the applicant towards interest.</p> <p>The earlier Execution Application was dismissed being infructuous on the statement of applicant's Ld. Counsel on the premise that order has been complied with, whereas it is not as such, therefore, direction be issued to respondents to issue Corrigendum PPO for payment of interest also.</p> <p>The Ld. Counsel for the respondents has vehemently opposed the submissions on the ground that earlier Execution Application No. 07 of 2021 has been dismissed on 22.09.2021 being infructuous on statement of applicant's Ld. Counsel, therefore, second Execution Application is not maintainable.</p> <p>Upon hearing submissions of Ld. Counsel of both sides we find that there is a direction to pay interest also which applicant claims to have not been paid to him. We also find that in the Discharge Book issued to the applicant his Character has not been assessed which also needs to be assessed in terms of order.</p> <p>The Ld.
