Applicant has filed this O.A. under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007. The following prayers have been made:-</p> <p>(i) To issue/pass an order to set aside/quash the order/letter No 14244529/NER/ACP/MACP dated 19.10.2019 sent by the respondent No 3.</p> <p>(ii) To issue/pass an order or directions to the respondents to revise the applicant's pension as per ACP-I Nk (equivalent to Hav) from the date of discharge i.e. 01.04.2004 alongwith 12% interest on arrear and grant monthly revised pension as per ACP-I Nk (equivalent to Hav) 5th CPC.</p> <p>(iii) To issue/pass any other order or direction as this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem just, fit and proper under the circumstances of the case in favour of the applicant.</p> <p>(iv) Allow this original application with costs.</p> <p>2. Brief facts of the case are that the applicant was enrolled in the Army on 20.03.1982 and he was discharged from service w.e.f. 01.04.2004 (FB) after completion of terms of engagement under Rule 13 (3) III (i) of Army Rules, 1954. He was granted service pension vide PPO No S/079558/2003 (Army). On getting to know that his colleague Shiv Kishore was receiving more pension than him, he preferred a complaint to PCDA (P), Allahabad, reply of which was received on 24.10.2018 wherein it was stated that the rank of pension in respect of Shiv Kishore is Nk (ACP-I) (i.e. equivalent to Hav) whereas the applicant's rank for pension is Nk as per records held with them. Thereafter, he preferred another representation dated 18.09.2019 which was rejected vide letter dated 19.10.2019 stating that the applicant was not granted ACP-I due to lacking mandatory 'N' Cadre. It is in this perspective that this O.A. has been filed for grant of ACP-I to the applicant.</p>

3. Submission of learned counsel for the applicant is that the applicant is very much entitled to ACP-I as he was discharged from the service on 01.04.2004 and the scheme was made applicable between the period 07.08.2003 to 31.08.2008. He further submitted that later ACP was converted into MACP and it was made effective w.e.f. 01.01.2006. His further submission is that the ACP is a financial upgradation and not a promotion criteria and since the applicant retired from service after completion of more than 22 years of service, he is entitled to ACP-I (i.e. equivalent to Hav).

4. On the other hand learned counsel for the respondents while filing counter affidavit stated that the ACP scheme was made effective from August 2003 as per IHQ of MoD (Army) letter dated 29.09.2003 and was granted to those personnel who fulfilled promotion criteria. He further submitted that since the applicant was lacking mandatory cadre, he was not granted ACP-I. He pleaded for dismissal of O.A.

5. Heard Shri JN Mishra, Ld. Counsel for the applicant and Dr. Gyan Singh, Ld. Counsel for the respondents and perused the material placed on record.

6. There is no dispute that the applicant was enrolled in the Army on 20.03.1982 and he was discharged from service w.e.f. 01.04.2003 (FN) after completing more than 22 years of service. In the Army ACP scheme was introduced w.e.f. 07.08.2003 for two financial upgradations at an interval of 10 and 20 years of service from the date of enrolment as per policy letter dated 29.09.2003. Salient aspects for grant of ACP upgradation are as under:-

(i) There are two ACP upgradations; first, to the scale of Naik and equivalent after 10 years of service and second, to the scale of Havildar and equivalent after 20 years of service.

(ii) Individuals are screened by a Screening Board for grant of ACP, which is the same as DPC/promotion board held for promotion purpose.

(iii) ACP upgradation is subject to meeting the criteria like discipline, educational qualification, trade classification etc as laid down in the Govt letter.

(iv) Individual is given option to be exercised within one month of grant of ACP to have pay fixed in the new scale either straightway or from the date of grant of next increment in the existing scale.

(v) Pay fixation in the new scale is subject to a minimum financial benefit of Rs 100/- p.m.

7. Admittedly, the applicant had completed more than 20 years service when the scheme was introduced, therefore, the applicant is entitled to ACP-I. During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the respondents produced letter dated 14.01.2021 by which respondents conceded that the applicant is entitled to grant of ACP-I (i.e. equivalent to Hav). As per respondents'

avertment letter dated 14.01.2021 has already been sent to SBI, CPPC, Lucknow for revision of his service pension. The aforesaid letter clearly lays down that applicant be paid revised pension as per circular 555 and 570 of PCDA (P), Allahabad. For convenience sake, extract of letter dated 14.01.2021 is reproduced as under:-

1. *It is intimated that No.14244529A Ex Nk Ram Babu Pal who is drawing his Service Pension from your bank branch vide Account No. 10346882428 has represented to this office through CP Gram Regn. No. PMOPG/E/2021/0019753 dated 10 Jan 2021 that your bank branch has not revised his Service Pension / Arrears to the rank of Nk of qualifying service 22 yrs and 11 days as per Table No.7 of PCDA (P) Prayagraj Circular No. 555 dated 04 Feb 2016 and 570 dated 31 Oct 2016. All PDAs are authorized to revise their Service Pension /Arrears and no corrigendum PPO is required to be issued from Pension Sanctioning Authority.*

2. *As per RBI direction vide item 34 of Master Circular No. RBI/2013-13/103 DGBA. GAD No. H-4/31.05.001/2013-13 dt 02 July 2012 on disbursement of pension / arrears by banks, the benefits announced by Govt. is required to be paid in the succeeding month's pension payment itself to the pensioners. In case there is a delay in payment the bank has to compensate the pensioner at a fixed interest of 8% for the delay after due date. Hence you are requested to make the payment to the pensioner with interest of 8% and inform this office at the earliest.*

3. *In view at the above, you are requested to look into the matter and revise his Service Pension to the rank of Nk at the earliest to avoid and legal complication at later stage. Onus for delay in making payment of revised rate of Service Pension the ESM will be rests with you.*

This application has been filed against the order of discharge and for the grant of disability pension.</p> <p>3. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents submits that against the order of discharge applicant's husband had earlier filed a Civil Misc Writ Petition No 6764 of 1998 in the Hon'ble Patna High Court which he later got withdrawn with liberty to file appeal before the appropriate authority. Thereafter, he filed an appeal which was dismissed. Thereafter, he filed Civil Misc Writ Petition No 6394 of 1999 for the reliefs he had prayed in the earlier petition which was dismissed on 16.05.2001 on merit and applicant was held not entitled to the reliefs claimed. Thereafter, he filed a fresh petition in the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Allahabad for the same reliefs which was later transferred to this Bench being the instant Transferred Application which is barred under Section 11 of the Civil Procedure Code. He submits that matter in issue between the parties being once finally decided by Hon'ble Patna High Court cannot be re-decided between the same parties or the parties claiming through them by this Tribunal as it is barred by Res Judicata under Section 11 of the Civil Procedure Code (in short "CPC"). Thus, he submits that instant Transferred Application is barred under Section 11 of the C.P.C. and therefore dismissed as such.</p> <p>4. In reply, learned counsel for the applicant submits that he has no idea about the filing of Writ Petition No 6394 of 1999. He further submits that even for the sake of argument it is assumed that applicant's husband had filed Writ Petition No 6394 of 1999 which had been dismissed on merit on 16.05.2001, looking to miserable condition of the applicant the matter in issue may be re-decided instead of being dismissed in view of Section 11 C.P.C.</p>

5. It is settled in law that a matter in issue being once finally decided between the parties cannot be re-decided between the same parties or the parties claiming through them as it is barred under Section 11 of the Civil Procedure Code.

6. It appears that applicant's husband was discharged from service on 31.03.1998 being an undesirable soldier. Against the order of discharge he had filed a Civil Misc Writ Petition No 6764 of 1998 in the Patna High Court which was later withdrawn with liberty to file appeal before the appropriate authority. He filed an appeal against the order of discharge which was dismissed. Thereafter, he filed Civil Misc Writ Petition No 6394 of 1999 in the Patna High Court against the order of discharge which was dismissed on merit on 16.05.2001 and order of discharge was held being not suffered with any illegality. The order dated 16.05.2001 has become final between the parties as no appeal is said to have been filed against it. The plea of having no idea about filing of Writ Petition No 6394 of 1999 and the same being dismissed on 16.05.2001 on merit is nothing but a false pretence which is not acceptable. The matter of discharge of the applicant's husband has been finally decided and it cannot be re-decided in the instant Transferred Application as it is barred by Res Judicata under Section 11 of the CPC. The order dated 16.05.2001 of the Patna High Court is binding on the applicant as she is claiming her right through her husband who had filed the Writ Petition No 6394 of 1999. Instant Transferred Application is barred by Res Judicata and is, therefore, liable to be dismissed as such.

7. Matter of discharge of the applicant's husband cannot be re-adjudicated on the reason that her condition is miserable.

8. In view of the above, the Transferred Application is **dismissed**.

9. No order as to costs.
