Counsel for the respondents.</p> <p>This is an application to recall the order dated 21.09.2015 passed in transferred Application No. 1244 of 2010 by which Original Application was dismissed being not pressed at the stage of final hearing.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the then counsel of the applicant Shri P.N. Chaturvedi had not taken instructions from the applicant before making statements in court during course of final hearing that application may be dismissed as not pressed nor applicant had ever instructed him to not press the application. Applicant came to know about dismissal of application much after the dismissal of application. Applicant will suffer a great loss if the order is not recalled.</p> <p>He further submits that delay of 04 years, 07 months and 22 days in filing of recall application is not deliberate. Applicant was busy taking care of his wife who was seriously ill as a result of which he could not file the recall application in time.</p> <p>Per contra, learned counsel for the respondents submits that recall application is not maintainable. Impugned order has been passed on statements of learned counsel for the applicant made during course of final arguments that he does not want to press the application and not in default.</p> <p>He further submits that there is inordinate delay of more than five years in filing of application which has not been properly and satisfactorily explained.</p> <p>Upon hearing submissions of learned counsel of both sides we find that application has not been dismissed in default but during final hearing of case on statements made by the then counsel of the applicant that he does not want to press the application. We further find that applicant's plea that his counsel had no authority to not press the application, as he was not instructed by him for that, is an afterthought after long time of dismissal of the application to get the recall of the order. Had it been a fact then recall application would have been filed immediately after applicant</p>

came to know about the order. He would never wait such a long time for filing the application.

We further find that cause shown for the delay is not true. No cogent evidence has been filed regarding illness of applicant's wife. In absence of cogent evidence the plea taken by the applicant for delay is not acceptable.

In view of above, delay caused in filing of application is not liable to be condoned and application deserves to be dismissed as such. Even otherwise application does not stand on merit as cause assigned for recall is not true rather it is an afterthought. Thus application deserves to be dismissed.

Accordingly, both the delay condonation application and recall application are dismissed.
