Counsel for the applicant submits that an affidavit which has been filed by the applicant on 04.03.2022 be taken on record. The affidavit is based on subsequent events after the filing of Execution Application.</p> <p>The Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that despite lapse of two months after passing of the order dated 07.01.2022 in Original Application No.619 of 2021 the respondents have neither implemented the order nor filed Appeal against the order, which shows their intention that they are simply passing the time in the garb of filing of Appeal. The respondents do not intend to implement the order which is clear from the fact that after the filing of Execution Application they have promoted an officer to the rank of Major General in Judge Advocate General's Branch, who is junior to the applicant and they are also trying to fill up the second post of Major General by calling for a meeting of No. 1 Selection Board scheduled to take place in April, 2022 vide MS Branch letter dated 16.02.2022.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the applicant further submits that after applicant's plea of keeping his retirement in abeyance being not granted by the Tribunal vide its order dated 15.02.2022 the applicant had filed a Writ Petition being Writ – A No. 1006 of 2022, Brigadier Javed Iqbal Versus Union of India and Others, under Article 226 of Constitution of India in Lucknow Bench of Hon'ble Allahabad High Court which was disposed off on 25.02.2022. The Hon'ble High Court vide order its dated 25.02.2022 while directing this Tribunal for expediting the Execution Application and concluding the same preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of order has kept the retirement of the applicant in abeyance till the final disposal of Execution Application. The Hon'ble High Court has also restrained the respondents from filling the post of</p>

Additional Major General (Litigation) in the Judge Advocate General's Branch till disposal of Execution Application.

The Ld. Counsel for the respondents has no objection taking affidavit on record. Accordingly, affidavit is taken on record.

The Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that since now there is no impediment in implementation of the order passed in Original Application after the period of Appeal under Section 30 read with Section 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 is over, necessary direction be issued to the respondents to implement the order at the earliest, preferably within a period of three days.

The learned counsel for the respondents, on the other hand, submits that respondents have every intention to file appeal but as several agencies are involved in the process, appeal could not be filed. Appeal is likely to be filed in the coming week, therefore, learned counsel submits that time be granted to file appeal and bring the stay order.

Considering the submissions of learned counsel of both sides and also that no appeal has been filed in the matter in view of Section 30 read with Section 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, and, as such, there is no impediment in implementation of the order, respondents are directed to implement the order within two weeks failing which the matter would be seriously viewed.
