Counsel for the respondents assisted by Capt Priyanka, Departmental Representative for the respondents.</p> <p>Being in low medical category applicant was discharged from service on 31.10.2004 under Army Rule 13 (3) (i) (a) read in conjunction with Sub Rule 2 A on completion of 26 years and six days of service. The Release Medical Board held on 20.07.2004 at Military Hospital Mathura opined that applicant was suffering with disability (i) "Chronic Duodenal Ulcer Old (Optd)" @ 20% for life as aggravated by military service and (ii) disability "CAD IF Wall MI SVD PTCA RCA Done" @ 40% for life as aggravated by military service and the composite assessment for both the disabilities was 60% for life. The claim forwarded for grant of disability element in regard to above disabilities was declined by PCDA (P), Allahabad against which applicant had filed O.A. No 225 of 2019 Nb Sub Gajadhar Prasad vs Union of India & Others which was partly allowed on 03.04.2019 directing the respondents to pay disability pension to the applicant @ 20% to be rounded off to 50% for life for disability (i) "Chronic Duodenal Ulcer Old (Optd)". In regard to (ii) disability "CAD IF Wall MI SVD PTCA RCA Done", the respondents were directed to hold fresh RSMB to finally decide the issue of attributability and percentage as earlier opinion of PCDA (P), Allahabad was based without holding physical medical examination.</p> <p>In Re-survey Medical Board applicant has been found suffering with the same two disabilities (i) "Chronic Duodenal Ulcer Old (Optd)" @ 20% for life and (ii) disability "CAD IF Wall MI SVD PTCA RCA Done" @ 60% for life and composite assessment has been assessed @ 68% for life. In regard to (ii) disability (ii)"CAD IF Wall MI SVD PTCA RCA Done", the Re-survey Medical Board has considered that it is not attributable to military service.</p>

On 03.12.2021, when the matter was taken up for hearing we passed the order directing the respondents to issue Corrigendum PPO to the applicant for both the disabilities @ 68% to be rounded of to 75% for life assuming the issue of attributability has been considered which is incorrect. Since in Resurvey Medical Board 2nd disability i.e. "CAD IF Wall MI SVD PTCA RCA Done", has been held not attributable to military service and the issue needs to be adjudicated, which is not permissible in this execution proceedings. This can be done in O.A. only. As regards disability (i), it is not disputed that PPO has been generated and applicant is in receipt of disability element.

In view of aforesaid, we recall the order dated 03.12.2021 directing the respondents to issue Corrigendum PPO in the matter. In view of the fact that order dated 03.04.2019 has been complied with, Execution Application deserves to be dismissed being infructuous.

Accordingly, Execution Application is **dismissed**.
