On perusal of the letter it appears that Government Sanction has been accorded to grant 100% disability element to the applicant with effect from 22.10.2019, the date on which RSMB was held.</p> <p>It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the applicant that since in the RSMB applicant has been found suffering with same disability and degree of the disability is also same which applicant had at the time of discharge, he should be granted disability element of the pension from three years prior to filing of Original Application and not from the date of RSMB.</p> <p>On the other hand, Ld. Counsel for the respondents submits that there is no such direction in the order that in the event of disability being found in the RSMB the same would be allowed from three years prior from the date of filing of the Original Application, therefore, the Government Sanction which has been accorded in the matter is strictly in order.</p> <p>Upon hearing submissions of Ld. Counsel of both sides we find that applicant was suffering with "AIDS (HIV INFECTION + PULMONARY T.B.) B-20" @100% for two years at the time of discharge i.e. 02.02.2003. The RSMB has been held on 22.10.2019 in which he has been found suffering same disability and degree of disability is also same. From this it can be conveniently</p>

inferred that disability of the applicant remained same during the intervening period and, in that situation, applicant is entitled to disability element of pension from three years prior to filing of the Original Application and not from the date of RSMB.

Respondents are, therefore, directed to correct the Government Sanction and grant disability element of pension to the applicant from three years prior to filing of the Original Application. The date of filing of Original Application is 22.12.2016.

Affidavit of compliance be filed within four weeks from today.

The respondents are further directed to give effect to this order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the respondents fail to give effect to this order within the stipulated time, they will have to pay interest @8% on the amount accrued from due date till the date of actual payment.”</i></p> <p>It is a settled proposition of law that the scope of the review is limited and until it is shown that there is error apparent on the face of record in the judgment and order sought to be reviewed, the same cannot be reviewed</p>

For ready reference, Order 47, Rule 1 sub-rule (1) of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 is reproduced below :-

“1. Application for review of judgment.- (1) any person considering himself aggrieved-

*(a) by a decree or order from which an appeal is allowed, but from which no appeal has been preferred,
(b) by a decree or order from which no appeal is allowed, or
(c) by a decision on a reference from a Court of Small Causes, and who, from the discovery of new and important matter or evidence which, after the exercise of due diligence, was not within his knowledge or could not be produced by him at the time when the decree was passed or order made, or on account of some mistake or error apparent on the face of the record , or for any other sufficient reason, desires to obtain a review of the decree passed or order made against him, may apply for a review of judgment to the Court which passed the decree or made the order.”*

In view of the principles of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in various decisions, it is settled that the scope of review jurisdiction is very limited and re-hearing is not permissible. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in Para 9 of its judgment in the case of ***Parsion Devi and others vs. Sumitri Devi and others***, reported in (1997) 8 Supreme Court Cases 715, has observed as under :-

“9. Under Order 47, Rule 1 CPC a judgment may be open to review inter alia if there is a mistake or an error apparent on the face of the record. An error which is not self- evident and has to be detected by a process of reasoning, can hardly be said to be an error apparent on the face of the record justifying the court to exercise its power of review under Order 47, Rule 1 CPC. In exercise of the jurisdiction under Order 47, Rule 1 CPC it is not permissible for an erroneous decision to be "reheard and corrected". There is a clear distinction between an erroneous decision and an error apparent on the face of the record. While the first can be corrected by the higher forum, the latter only can be corrected by exercise of the review jurisdiction. A review petition has a limited purpose and cannot be allowed to be "an appeal in disguise."

We have gone through the judgment and order sought to be reviewed and no illegality or irregularity or error apparent on the face of record being found therein, we are of the view that there is no force in the grounds taken in the review application so that order may be reviewed.

In the result, Review Application is **rejected**.
