Twenty Lac and Twenty Thousand) to the applicant against the opposite parties.</p> <p>(iii) That this Hon'ble Tribunal may be pleased to pass any other order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem just and proper be passed in favour of the applicant."</p> <p>Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that applicant was enrolled in the Territorial Army on 08.12.1974 and discharged from service on 08.05.1980 and re-enrolled in DSC on 08.05.1980 as Sepoy and discharged from DSC on 31.01.2012 after rendering about thirty seven years of service including five years of T.A. service. He further submitted that applicant was granted the rank of Nb Sub vide Part II Order dated 27.01.2012, however, applicant is getting pension of the rank of Naik vide PPO No. S/011167/2011 which is wholly against the law. The applicant submitted many applications but</p>

the same have not been replied by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the applicant also placed reliance on the judgment of this Tribunal in OA No. 237 of 2018, ***Ex Nk Avtarnath vs. Union of India and Others***, decided on 12.07.2021 and pleaded that applicant's case is similar in nature and he is entitled for the pension to the rank of MACP Nb Sub Grade III w.e.f. 01.02.2012.

On the other hand, Ld. Counsel for the respondents submitted that applicant was enrolled in DSC on 08.05.1980 and he opted to count his former service of T.A. towards DSC service. The applicant was discharged from DSC service on 31.01.2012 in low medical category on attaining age of 55 years for which he is in receipt of service pension and disability element.

Learned counsel for the respondents further submitted that benefit of MACP was initially not extended to DSC personnel as per policy laid down vide IHQ of MoD (Army) letter dated 12.03.2013 since service in DSC was considered as a second employment. Now the Government has accepted the financial upgradation under MACP to DSC personnel also w.e.f. 01.01.2016 vide Govt. of India, Gazette Notification No. 02 dated 05.09.2016. However, the administrative instruction/guidelines for implementation of the same is under preparation at Service Headquarters and therefore, applicant's case will be processed for revised pensionary benefits under MACP scheme, subject to meeting the other eligibility criteria.

It is clarified that benefit of judgment relied by learned counsel for the applicant in the case of ***Ex Nk Avtarnath*** (supra), cannot be extended to the applicant as benefit of MACP in that case was granted for the services rendered in the Army and not in DSC.

In view of aforesaid, we find that grant of benefit of MACP to DSC personnel is under consideration at IHQ of MoD (Army) and therefore, Original Application of the applicant is disposed off finally with directions to the respondents to consider applicant's case for benefit of MACP as per instructions/guidelines on the subject for DSC Personnel within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

No order as to costs.
