Cdr. Ajit Kakkar (Retd.), Ld. Counsel for the applicant and Capt. Priyanka, Departmental Representative for the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 are present.</p> <p>This application has been filed for implementation of order dated 22.02.2021 of this Tribunal in Original Application No. 240 of 2020.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that vide order dated 22.02.2021 the Tribunal had directed the respondents to pay disability pension to the applicant @60% for two years from the date of discharge and to conduct Re-Survey Medical Board for the applicant to assess his further entitlement of disability pension. The respondents were directed to complete the exercise within a time of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order with stipulation that default will invite interest @8% per annum. He further submits that order has not been complied with.
