Regarding compliance of the order dated 31.08.2021, learned counsel submitted that no deduction has ever been made from the pension of the applicant @ Rs. 12000/- per month as applicant claims, rather deduction was made @ Rs. 4910/- from the month of Feb. 2020 and March 2020 to Sep. 2021 @ Rs. 4312/-. He further submitted that a sum of Rs. 82526/- had been deducted from the applicant's account which has been repaid to him by crediting this amount in his account on 29.12.2021, i.e. within four months from the date of order. Thus, he submitted that there is no violation of the order passed by this Tribunal wherefore Contempt Application filed by the applicant deserves to be dismissed.</p> <p>Upon hearing submissions of both sides, we find that in regard to excess amount paid to the applicant towards payment of enhanced rate of family pension, a sum of Rs. 82526/- had been deducted from the monthly pension of</p> |

the applicant @ Rs. 4910/- for the month of Feb. 2020 and Rs. 4312/- from Mar. 2020 to Sep. 2021 which was ordered to be repaid to the applicant vide our order dated 31.08.2021.

In compliance of the said order, the recovered amount has been credited in applicant's account on 29.12.2021. Thus, order passed in O.A. seems to have been fully complied with and, in view of this, Contempt Application deserves to be dismissed.
