Rajveer Singh Versus Union of India & Others, before this Tribunal, which was allowed and respondents were directed to carry out RSMB on applicant within four months to decide his present medical category vide order 15.01.2021.</p> <p>In compliance of the said order, Sanction for Holding Re-Assessment Medical Board was issued by the respondents vide their letter No.76101/RAMB/DGMS-5A dated 23.03.2021 wherein in para 3 it has been directed that "<i>Hospital will not comment on aggravation/attributability.</i>" On the basis of aforesaid sanction, the RSMB of applicant has been held at Base Hospital, Lucknow on 03.06.2021 wherein applicant's disability has been</p>

assessed @20% for life but the columns "*Attributable to service (Y/N)*" and "*Aggravated by service (Y/N)*" only – (dash) have been mentioned and in the column it has been written that "*As per Court case order dt 20/01/2021 & DGMS Letter No. 76101/RAMB/DGMS-5A Dt 23/03/2021 enclosed*".

Ld. Counsel for the applicant submitted that due to non mentioning of aggravation/attributability the applicant's entitlement of disability pension cannot be adjudicated.

Ld. Counsel for the respondents has opposed the prayer stating that order passed by this Tribunal has been complied in all respect.

Upon hearing submissions of Ld. Counsel of parties, we are of the opinion that third para of letter No.76101/RAMB/DGMS-5A dated 23.03.2021 mentioning "*Hospital will not comment on aggravation/attributability*" is required to be deleted so that entitlement of applicant's disability pension can be adjudicated.

In view of above, **Original Application No. 663 of 2021 is allowed.** Respondents are directed to delete para 3 of letter No.76101/RAMB/DGMS-5A dated 23.03.2021 mentioning "*Hospital will not comment on aggravation/attributability*" and issue instruction to Hospital to comment on aggravation/attributability of the applicant's disability so that further entitlement of disability pension can be ascertained. The respondents are further directed to give effect to this order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Default will invite interest @ 8% per annum till the actual payment.
