While drawing our attention of Page No. 4 of the Supplementary Affidavit dated 04.10.2021 Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of applicant submits that it shows that after dismissal of the applicant being set aside he has been reinstated in the rank of Naik, not in the rank of Haviladar which he was holding before the Summary Court Martial. Thus, his submission is that respondents have not implemented the order in its perspective, therefore, a direction be issued to them to implement the order in letter and spirit.

In reply, the Ld. Counsel for the respondents submits that in current PPO No. 157201803025 dated 17.08.2018 issued in the matter applicant has been shown in the rank of Naik ACP-I which is equivalent to rank of Havildar and applicant has also been receiving the pension in the same rank i.e. Havildar. Thus, he submits that there is no discrepancy in the implementation of the order, rather the order being implemented as it is, Execution Application should be dismissed being infructuous.

During the course of hearing Shri Rajeev Tiwari, Accounts Officer, Principal Controller of Defence Accounts (Pension), Prayagraj (Allahabad) is present in the Court and he submits that post of Naik ACP-I and Havildar are one and the same. He also submits that applicant is receiving pension of Havildar (Pay Matrix Level – 5).

It is not disputed that when applicant was dismissed from service he was in the rank of Havildar and as per PPO No. 157201803025 dated 17.08.2018 the applicant is not only placed in the rank of Naik ACP-I which is equivalent to Havildar but he is also receiving pension of Havildar which shows that there is no discrepancy in the implementation of the order, rather the order being correctly being implemented, the Execution Application deserves to be dismissed.

Accordingly, Execution Application is **dismissed** being infructuous.

The applicant was enrolled in the army on 17.06.2015. He was admitted in Military Hospital Hisar, where he was diagnosed a case of 'Adjustment disorder with brief depressive reaction for recat'. He was recommended to be invalided out of service by Classified Specialist (Psychiatry) of Base Hospital Delhi Cantt. He was invalided out from service in September 2017. Applicant approached various hospitals and doctors have not found applicant suffering with any psychiatry illness. The applicant represented his grievance with Higher Army authority vide his representation dated 03.11.2017 for re-enrolment in the army but no action was taken. By means of instant, O.A., applicant prays that discharge order issued by the respondents be quashed and directions be issued to re-enrol the applicant in the army.

Applicant was invalided out from service and he was not granted any disability pension. Applicant approached the doctors who assured that applicant is fit for re-enrolment in the army. As per para 143 of Regulations for the Army, 1987, ex-servicemen who are in receipt of disability pension will not be accepted for re-enrolment in the army. Ex-servicemen medically boarded out without any disability pension will be eligible for re-enrolment, either in combatant or non combatant (enrolled) capacity in the army, provided they are re-medically boarded and declared fit by the medical authorities. If such an exservicemen applies for re-enrolment and claims that he is entirely free from disability for which invalided, he will be medically examined by the Rgt Med Offr and if he considers him fit, the applicant will be advised to apply to officer in charge, records office concerned, through the recruiting officer for getting

himself re-medically boarded. If the individual if found fit and re-enrolled on regular engagement, he will be enlisted for the full period of combined colour and reserve service.

In the instant case applicant was not granted any disability pension. Further doctors in various hospitals have declared him fit for army service.

In view of above, respondents are directed to arrange re-medical examination of the applicant within two months and if the applicant is found fit, he shall be enrolled in the army as per rules.

With the aforesaid directions, the O.A. is disposed of finally.
