This Original Application has been filed for the grant of disability pension with delay of 33 years, 08 months and 20 days regarding which an application for condonation of delay, supported with affidavit, has been filed.

Submission of Ld. Counsel for the applicant is that delay in filing Original Application is not deliberate. His further submission is that applicant did not approach any court of law from 25.12.1985 to 05.10.2020 as he was suffering from '**SCHIZOPHRENIA**' (Mental Disorder) and unable to understand what is right or wrong and due to the said disability he is still moving with Battery Torch in day light and hence his mental condition can be adjudged. Thus, his submission is that delay is not deliberate, but for the reasons stated above.

Ld. Counsel for the respondents has vehemently opposed the prayer and has submitted that long delay of more than 33 years has not been properly and satisfactorily explained.

Having heard the submissions of Ld. Counsel of both sides and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we find that explanation offered by the applicant for delay in filing Original Application is not sufficient. We also find that service documents of the applicant, being non-pensioner, have been destroyed by burning on completion of its retention period of 25 years as per Para 595 to 597 of Regulations for the Army, 1987 (Revised Edition). It is settled in law that if time limit is given for filing of any application and the same is not filed within that time limit, delay should be explained on day to day basis which applicant has utterly failed in the present case.

In the result, we find that delay is not condonable.

Accordingly, delay condonation application is **rejected**.

Original Application being time barred is also **rejected**.

Counsel for the respondent Nos. 1 to 4.</p> <p>This application has been made to recall the order dated 17.12.2021 in Execution Application No. 57 of 2021 Inre : Original Application No. 719 of 2020 by which the Execution Application has been dismissed being infructuous.</p> <p>It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the applicant that in the affidavit of compliance dated 16.12.2021 filed on behalf of respondent No. 5 it has been stated that pension of the applicant has been revised in terms of Government of India, Ministry of Defence letter dated 21.02.2020 and PCDA, Allahabad Circular No. 631 dated 05.03.2020. It has been further stated that a sum of Rs.83,190/- has been credited in the applicant's account on 27.08.2020, and interest amount of Rs.19,141/- has been credited on 11.10.2021.</p> <p>It is further submitted that believing the aforesaid facts mentioned in the affidavit of compliance, Ld. Counsel for the applicant, during the course of hearing in Execution Application on 17.12.2021, made a statement that Execution Application may be dismissed being infructuous and based on the said statement of the Ld. Counsel of the applicant the Execution Application has been dismissed being infructuous. However, when applicant got the statement of his account it was found that there was no such credit entry on 27.08.2020 and 11.10.2021 as stated in the affidavit of compliance. It is submitted that applicant's Counsel had made statement in Tribunal believing the fact stated in affidavit of compliance to be true. However, the statement being not correct as per statement of account, the order dated 17.12.2021 in Execution Application No. 57 of 2021 needs to be recalled for a fresh hearing.</p>

We have gone through the statement of account filed by the applicant along with recall application and we find that a sum of Rs.2,38,674/- has been credited in the account of applicant on 17.08.2020 towards pensionary benefits which, undoubtedly, is the amount of arrear paid to the applicant after the revision of pension. This shows that in view of Government of India, Ministry of Defence letter dated 21.02.2020 and PCDA (Pension), Allahabad Circular No.631 dated 05.03.2020 the pension of the applicant has been revised and arrears have been credited. Thus order seems to have been complied with. With regard to entries dated 27.08.2020 and 11.10.2021, as stated in the affidavit of compliance, there is no such entry in the statement of account. It appears that respondent No. 5 was not aware about the amount paid as arrears to the applicant and also the date when payment was made. But, for this error, compliance cannot be disbelieved nor the order under recall can be taken back. As regard mentioning of wrong amount and wrong date, respondent No. 5 is warned to be careful in future while filing the affidavit in this Tribunal.

Recall application is disposed off accordingly.
