	Further submission of Ld. Counsel for the respondents is that since documents

relating to applicant may have been destroyed on expiry of mandatory retention period
of 25 years being a non-pensioner, therefore, family pension cannot be granted at this
stage.
Having heard the submissions of Ld. Counsel of both sides and considering
the facts and circumstances of the case, we find that explanation offered by the
applicant for delay in filing Original Application is not sufficient. It is settled in law that if
time limit is given for filing of any application and the same is not filed within that time
limit, delay should be explained on day to day basis which applicant has utterly failed
in the present case. Further, we find that documents relating to ex army person have
been destroyed after mandatory retention period in terms of para 595 of Regulations
for the Army, 1987. We could have decided the case, had there been related
documents pertaining to the applicant's husband and applicant could have been
benefitted, but we are unable to impart justice in the absence of requisite documents
In the result, we find that delay is not condonable.
Accordingly, delay condonation application is dismissed.
Original Application being time barred is also dismissed .

	This Original Application has been filed by the applicant under Section
	14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 for the following reliefs:-
	(i) That this Hon'ble Tribunal may kindly be pleased to direct the opp. parties to grant the additional service pension at the rate of 20% to the applicant from the date of attaining the age of eighty years i.e. 03.01.2022, and provide the interest on the aforesaid delayed amount of additional pension with 18% p.a. since due date to actual date of payment, in the interest of justice.
	(ii) That this Hon'ble Tribunal may kindly be awarded the cost Rs. 20,20,000/- (Rs. Twenty Lac and Twenty Thousand) to the applicant against the opposite parties.
	(iii) That this Hon'ble Tribunal may be pleased to pass any other order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem just and proper be passed in favour of the applicant."
	Submission of learned counsel for the applicant is that applicant was
	enrolled in the Army on 15.02.1963 and was discharged from service on
	01.03.1991 after rendering more than 28 years of service. The applicant is in
	receipt of service pension. The date of birth of the applicant is 02.01.1943 and
	his additional pension @ 20% should be started from the beginning of 80 years
	of age i.e. w.e.f. 03.01.2022 but the opposite parties have not granted the

same to the applicant.

Learned counsel for the applicant placed reliance on the judgement of AFT (PB), New Delhi in OA No. 1102 of 2022, **Sqn Ldr Yogesh Kumar Choudhary vs. Union of India and Others**, decided on 14.07.2022 and pleaded that applicant is entitled to 20% of additional pension from the beginning of 80 years of age, i.e. just after completion of 79 years of age, w.e.f. 03.01.2022 but the same has not been released by the respondents in very illegal and arbitrary manner ignoring the settled position of law.

Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that since date of birth of the applicant is 02.01.1943 and he will attain 80 years of age on 02.01.2023, therefore, the applicant is presently ineligible for 20% additional pension and Original Application has been filed prematurely. He will however, become eligible for additional pension @ 20% on 02.01.2023 after attaining the age of 80 years. He also submitted that as per Para 12 of Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence letter dated 11.11.2008, additional quantum of pension on attaining the age of 80 years will be paid directly by the PDA as per date of birth recorded in PPO.

In view of above, we are of the view that applicant has filed the present Original Application prematurely because the applicant will be entitled to 20% additional pension on 02.01.2023 after attaining the age of 80 years as per rules/policy on the subject. The benefit of **Sqn Ldr Yogesh Kumar Choudhary** (supra) case cannot be extended to the applicant as this judgment is based on Gowahati Bench judgment and rules regarding release of additional quantum of pension have not be amended yet rather in case of High Court Judges and Supreme Court Judges, an Act, "High Court and Supreme Court Judges (Salaries and Conditions of Service), Amendment Act, 2021" has been passed and published in the Gazette of India, No. 61 dated 20.12.2021 in which it is explained/clarified by making amendment in Section 16B and 17B of the High Court and Supreme Court Judges (Salaries and Conditions of Service) Act, 1954 :-

"Explanation – For the removal of doubts, it is hereby clarified that any entitlement for additional quantum of pension or family pension shall be and shall be deemed always to have been, from the first day of the month in which the pensioner or family pensioner completes the age specified in the first column of the scale."

From the aforesaid explanation, it is clear that applicant will be eligible

for 20% additional quantum of pension on first day of the month in which he completes 80 years of age, i.e. w.e.f. 01.01.2023. Hence, the Original Application filed prematurely cannot be admitted for hearing, deserves to be dismissed at the admission stage itself and is accordingly **dismissed** at admission stage only. Delay condonation application (MA No. 1200 of 2022) also stands dismissed. No order as to costs. (Vice Admiral Abhay Raghunath Karve) (Justice Umesh Chandra Srivastava) Member (A)
