Pandey and Shri Rajesh Kumar Pundir, Ld. Counsel for the applicant and Shri Arun Kumar Sahu, Ld. Counsel for the respondents.</p> <p>2. The instant Original Application has been filed on behalf of the applicant under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, whereby the applicant has sought following reliefs:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) To issue an order/direction to respondents to round off of disability element w.e.f. 01.01.1996.</li><li>(b) To issue an order/direction to pay arrears of amount accrued from 01.01.1996 till 26.10.2013.</li><li>(c) Any other relief as considered proper by this Hon'ble Tribunal be awarded in favour of the applicant.</li><li>(d) Cost of the O.A. be awarded to the applicant.</li></ul> <p>3. Briefly stated facts of the case are that the husband of the applicant was enrolled in Indian Navy on 30.09.1948 and was discharged from service on 30.09.1980 (AN) in low medical category. The Release Medical Board identified his disability "<b>FRACTURE BOTH BONES OF LEFT FOREARM EFFECTS OF ICD NO. 434</b>" and assessed it @30% as attributable to Naval service. Accordingly, he was granted disability pension @30% from 01.10.1980 to 23.09.1982. Thereafter, successive RSMBs held in respect of applicant's husband had extended the disability award and finally he was sanctioned Disability Pension for life vide PPO dated 15.04.1987. The applicant submitted forms for benefit of broad banding of her late husband's disability from 30% to 50% but of no avail. The applicant served legal notice for grant of rounding off benefit @50% but of no avail. The applicant's husband was in receipt of 30% disability pension till his death i.e. 26.10.2013 and now the applicant has moved this Original Application for grant of benefit of rounding off of disability pension from 30% to 50% till his husband's death.</p>

4. Ld. Counsel for the applicant argued that since the applicant's husband was already in receipt of 30% disability element for life, therefore, in view of the Hon'ble Apex Court judgment in the case of **Union of India and Ors vs Ram Avtar & ors** (Civil appeal No. 418 of 2012 decided on 10th December 2014), the applicant is also entitled to benefit of rounding off of disability element @50% till his death i.e. 26.10.2013.

5. On the other hand, though Ld. Counsel for the respondents conceded grant of 30% disability element to the applicant's husband but contended that the applicant's husband was not entitled to the benefit of rounding off of disability element on the ground that the applicant's husband's services were not cut short as he was not invalidated out on account of his disability. In the instant case the applicant's husband was discharged from service on completion of his terms of engagement, therefore, the Ld. Counsel claimed that he is not eligible for the benefit of rounding off.

6. The law on the point of rounding off of disability pension is no more RES INTEGRA in view of the Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment in the case of **Union of India and Ors vs Ram Avtar & ors** (Civil appeal No 418 of 2012 decided on 10th December 2014) wherein the Hon'ble Apex Court has nodded in disapproval of the policy of the Government of India in granting the benefit of rounding off of disability pension only to the personnel who have been invalidated out of service and denying the same to the personnel who have retired on attaining the age of superannuation or on completion of their tenure of engagement. The relevant portion of the decision is excerpted below:-

*“4. By the present set of appeals, the appellant (s) raise the question, whether or not, an individual, who has retired on attaining the age of superannuation or on completion of his tenure of engagement, if found to be suffering from some disability which is attributable to or aggravated by the military service, is entitled to be granted the benefit of rounding off of disability pension. The appellant(s) herein would contend that, on the basis of Circular No 1(2)/97/D (Pen-C) issued by the Ministry of Defence, Government of India, dated 31.01.2001, the aforesaid benefit is made available only to an Armed Forces Personnel who is invalidated out of service, and not to any other category of Armed Forces Personnel mentioned hereinabove.*

*5. We have heard Learned Counsel for the parties to the lis.*

*6. We do not see any error in the impugned judgment (s) and order(s) and therefore, all the appeals which pertain to the concept of rounding off of the disability pension are dismissed, with no order as to costs.*

*7. The dismissal of these matters will be taken note of by the High Courts as well as by the Tribunals in granting appropriate relief to the pensioners before them, if any, who are getting or are entitled to the disability pension.*

*8. This Court grants six weeks' time from today to the appellant(s) to comply with the orders and directions passed by us.”*

7. In the instant case, there is no dispute that applicant's husband was in receipt of 30% disability element till his life time as this fact has been accepted by the respondents. In view of the settled law on this matter, we are of the considered opinion that the applicant's husband was entitled to the benefit of rounding off to 50% for life i.e. upto 26.10.2013 with effect from **01.01.1996**.

8. In view of the above, the **Original Application No. 768 of 2021** is allowed. The applicant's husband is held entitled to the benefit of rounding off of disability element from 30% for life to 50% till his life i.e. upto 26.10.2013 with effect from 01.01.1996. The respondents are directed to grant benefit of rounding off of disability element to the applicant's husband @50% from 01.01.1996 to till his death i.e. 26.10.2013 and pay the life time arrears due to the deceased soldier to the applicant. The respondents are directed to give effect to this order within a period of four months from the date applicant submits mandatory documents alongwith certified copy of this order. Defaults will invite interest @ 9% per annum from the due date till actual payment.

9. No order as to costs.
