It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the applicants herein that there was no causal connection between the death of husband of respondent herein and military service as he had not died while performing official duties rather he had consumed organochloric insecticide with the result his death had occurred. It is further submitted that applicants herein had taken this plea in Counter Affidavit, but the same was negated without summoning the viscera report, had viscera report been summoned the position would have been cleared that husband of the respondent herein had consumed poison on account of which he had died which had no connection at all with the military service. Thus, the Ld. Counsel for the applicants herein has submitted that since the Tribunal has passed the order based on presumption only without summoning the viscera report, it is an error apparent on the face of record, the order be reviewed and Original Application granting Special Family pension to the applicant be

dismissed.

Per contra, Ld. Counsel for the respondent herein submitted that it is wrong on the part of the applicants herein to submit that Tribunal's order allowing Special Family Pension to the applicant based on presumption. The plea regarding death of husband of the applicant after consuming organochloric insecticide was taken in the Counter Affidavit by the applicants herein and the same was considered and the Tribunal passed the order that death of husband of the respondent herein was attributable to military service, with the result Original Application was allowed. He submitted that there is no error apparent on the face of record so that order may be reviewed.

Ld. Counsel for the respondent herein further submitted that the order to be reviewed is dated 19.07.2021. The applicants herein had filed Leave to Appeal application against the order and after the same being dismissed by this Tribunal now they have filed the Review Application in order to cause delay in execution of the order.

Upon hearing submissions of Ld. Counsel of both sides and considering that plea on which the Review Application has been filed was taken in the Counter Affidavit of the applicants herein and pressed also during the course of arguments and was considered also while passing the impugned order we are of the considered view that there is no error apparent on the face of record so that order may be reviewed. It appears that in the garb of Review Application applicants herein want Tribunal to sit as Court of Appeal on its own order which is not permissible in law. The Review Application is devoid of merit and is, therefore, liable to be dismissed.

Review Application is **dismissed**.

	It is further submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the applicant that delay in

filing the Original Application is not deliberate and also that limitation is not

applicable in pensionary matter, more so when the applicant has been discharged from service in low medical category on medical reasons only.

The Ld. Counsel for the respondents has vehemently opposed the prayer and has submitted that there is long delay of 6448 days in filing the Original Application which has not been properly and satisfactorily explained on day-to-day basis wherefore delay should not be condoned.

Upon hearing submissions of Ld. Counsel of both sides and going through the Original Application No. 661 of 2022, copy filed today, we find that the said Original Application was filed for restoration of disability pension granted to the applicant in respect of second disability which has no connection at all with remaining two disabilities in respect of which the present Original Application has been filed. Thus, the Original Application in regard to these disabilities is maintainable.

As regards delay, we are of the view that pensionary benefits specially disability pension cannot be denied on the ground of delay as it is a recurring cause of action, therefore, delay in filing the Original Application is condoned. Delay condonation application stands disposed off accordingly.

	The file has been placed before us by Circulation. The Review Applicants have filed this application under Rule 18 of the

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Armed Forces Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 2008 by which applicants have prayed for review and setting aside the judgement and order dated 06.10.2021 of this Tribunal passed in Original Application No.137 of 2021 by which respondents have been directed to grant disability element to the applicant @20% for life to be rounded off to 50% for life w.e.f. three years preceding the date of filing of Original Application.

There is a delay of 01 year and 03 days (total 368 days) in filing of leave to application.

The applicants - Union of India & Others pleaded that delay in filing leave to appeal is not deliberate. They further pleaded that after receiving the judgment from AFT Legal Cell Headquarters Madhya UP Sub Area it was sent to Office-in-Charge, Armoured Corps, Records, Ahmednagar Camp and Chief of the Army Staff, thereafter higher authorities instructed to forward the legal opinion. After getting the legal opinion from Central Government Standing Counsel the respondents have directed to AFT Legal Cell MUBSA to file Review Application against the order. Thus, delay is not deliberate, but for the reasons stated above.

On going through the pleadings of the applicants - Union of India & others and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we find that explanation offered by the applicants for delay in filing Review Application is not sufficient. It is settled in law that if time limit is given for filing of any application and the same is not filed within that time limit, delay should be explained on day to day basis which applicant has utterly failed in the present case.

Further, It is a settled proposition of law that the scope of the review is limited and until it is shown that there is error apparent on the face of record in the judgment and order sought to be reviewed, the same cannot be reviewed.

For ready reference, Order 47, Rule 1 sub-rule (1) of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 is reproduced below:-

- "1. Application for review of judgment.- (1) any person considering himself aggrieved-
 - (a) by a decree or order from which an appeal is allowed, but from which no appeal has been preferred,
 - (b) by a decree or order from which no appeal is allowed, or
 - (c) by a decision on a reference from a Court of Small Causes, and who, from the discovery of new and important matter or evidence which, after the exercise of due diligence, was not within his knowledge or could not be produced by him at the time when the decree was passed or order made, or on account of some mistake or error apparent on the face of the record, or for any other sufficient reason, desires to obtain a review of the decree passed or order made against him, may apply for a review of judgment to the Court which passed the decree or made the order."

In view of the principles of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in various decisions, it is settled that the scope of review jurisdiction is very limited and re-hearing is not permissible. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in Para 9 of its judgment in the case of *Parsion Devi and others vs. Sumitri Devi and others*, reported in (1997) 8 Supreme Court Cases 715, has observed as under:-

"9. Under Order 47, Rule 1 CPC a judgment may be open to review inter alia if there is a mistake or an error apparent on the face of the record. An error which is not self- evident and has to be detected by a process of reasoning, can hardly be said to be an error apparent on the face of the record justifying the court to exercise its power of review under Order 47, Rule 1 CPC. In exercise of the jurisdiction under Order 47, Rule 1 CPC it is not permissible for an erroneous decision to be "reheard and corrected". There is a clear distinction between an erroneous decision and an error apparent on the face of the record. While the first can be corrected by the higher forum, the latter only can be corrected by exercise of the review jurisdiction. A review petition has a limited purpose and cannot be allowed to be "an appeal in disguise."

Further, the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Para 26 of its judgment in the case of *S. Madhusudhan Reddy Versus V. Narayana Reddy and Others*, Civil Appeal Nos. 5503-04 of 2022, decided on 18.08.2022, has observed as under:-

"26. As can be seen from the above exposition of law, it has been consistently held by this Court in several judicial pronouncements that the Court's jurisdiction of review, is not the same as that of an appeal. A judgment can be open to review if there is a mistake or an error apparent on the face of the record, but an error that has to be detected by a process of reasoning, cannot be described as an error apparent on the face of the record for the Court to exercise its powers of review under Order XLVII Rule 1 CPC. In the guise of exercising powers of review, the Court can correct a mistake but not substitute the view taken earlier merely because there is a possibility of taking two views in a matter. A judgment may also be open to review when any new or important matter of evidence has emerged after passing of the judgment, subject to the condition that such evidence was not within the knowledge of the party seeking review or could not be produced by it when the order was made

despite undertaking an exercise of due diligence. There is a clear distinction between an erroneous decision as against an error apparent on the face of the record. An erroneous decision can be corrected by the Superior Court, however an error apparent on the face of the record can only be corrected by exercising review jurisdiction. Yet another circumstance referred to in Order XLVII Rule 1 for reviewing a judgment has been described as "for any other sufficient reason". The said phrase has been explained to mean "a reason sufficient on grounds, at least analogous to those specified in the rule"

In the light of the legal position crystalized above, we have gone through the judgment and order sought to be reviewed and no illegality or irregularity or error apparent on the face of record being found therein, we are of the view that there is no force in the grounds taken in the review application so that order may be reviewed.

In the result, we find that delay is not condonable.

Accordingly, delay condonation application is **dismissed**.

Leave to Appeal is also **dismissed** being time barred as well as on merit.
