Counsel for the applicant submits that applicant was discharged from service in Low Medical Category on 22.11.1980 and Release Medical Board assessed his disability @30% for two years for the disability 'URETERIC DUPLICATION (RT) WITH PRIMARY TRACT INFECTION'. However, applicant was denied disability element of disability pension on the reason that disability was neither attributable to nor aggravated by military service, hence applicant was compelled to file Original Application No. 495 of 2017 for the grant of disability element which was disposed off vide letter dated 27.03.2019 and while holding that applicant was entitled for the disability element of pension for two years from the date of discharge respondents were directed to hold Re-Survey Medical Board of the applicant to assess his further disability, if any. In regard to grant of disability element for two years period the same was held barred by time. Consequent Re-Survey Medical Board of the applicant was held on 13.08.2019 in which he was found having the same disability with same percentage. Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that since in the Re-Survey Medical Board applicant has been found suffering with same disability with same degree he should be granted disability element of pension from the date of discharge including intervening period and not from the date of Re-Survey Medical Board.</p> <p>On the other hand, Ld. Counsel for the respondents submits that in view of order of the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of <i>Shiv Dass vs. Union of India</i>, reported in 2007 (3) SLR 445, applicant can be allowed disability element of pension from the date of Re-Survey Medical Board, or, at the most, from three years prior to filing of Original Application.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">We have gone through the order dated 27.03.2019 passed in Original</p>

Application No.495 of 2017 as well as Re-Survey Medical Board report and we find that in the Re-Survey Medical Board applicant has been found suffering with the same disability he had at the time when he was discharged from service with same degree. However, since due to law of limitation arrears for the period of two years has been held barred by time, we find that keeping in view that the applicant had same disability during the intervening period, he should be allowed disability element of pension @30% for life to be rounded off to 50% for life from three years prior to filing of the Original Application.

Accordingly, applicant is held entitled to disability element of pension @30% for life to be rounded off to 50% for life from three years prior to filing of Original Application. The date of filing of Original Application is 24.09.2015. Respondents are directed to issue Corrigendum PPO as above within four weeks from today and file affidavit of compliance.
