Heard Shri KK Mishra, learned counsel for the applicant and Dr. Shailendra Sharma Atal, learned counsel for the respondents on prayer of the applicant for interim relief.2. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the applicant was enrolled in Indian Army on 28.06.1992. He was promoted to the rank of Sub Maj on 01.01.2021. A Sub Maj is entitled to serve upto completion of 52 years of age, extendable by two years upto 54 years whichever is earlier. Screening medical board of the applicant for extension of two years of service was held on 04.10.2021 and he was recommended for extension of service by his Battalion 9 JAT and he was due for retirement on 31.12.2024. Second Screening Board dated 28.09.2022 of the applicant was held and applicant was declared unfit for two years extension of service. He has been issued order for retirement from service on 31.08.2023 vide discharge order dated 21.10.2022 by his Record Office.3. Learned counsel for the applicant further pleaded that the applicant was placed in Low Medical Category on 17.09.2010 while holding rank of Havildar. He was posted to various Field/Operational Areas during service and he was promoted to the rank of Sub Maj in low medical category. During March 2022, his unit was placed in Roorkee, where the applicant is presently posted. His character has been assessed as EXEMPLARY and he has been graded OUTSTANDING in his ACR grading for the year 2021-2022 by his present Commanding Officer. He was served a show cause notice dated 27.02.2023 asking him to explain as to why he should not be

Sent on discharge being low medical category. In reply to show cause notice the applicant submitted that he is due for retirement after one year and nine months and he may be permitted to continue his extended tenure of service. Learned counsel for the applicant pleaded that order of discharge with effect from 31.08.2023 be stayed and applicant be allowed to serve upto extended period i.e. 31.12.2024.

4. On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondents has raised preliminary objection on maintainability of the case. He submitted that applicant had filed a statutory complaint dated 15.02.2023 which was withdrawn by him on 17.03.2023. He has not availed any statutory remedy available to him and has approached this Tribunal without exhausting the same, hence this O.A. is not maintainable. He further submitted that Commanding Officer has power to discharge the applicants placed in low medical category when sheltered appointment is not available under the provisions of Integrated Headquarters of Min of Def (Army) letter No B/33098/AG/PS-2(c) dated 20.12.2010 as amended vide letter No B/33098/AG/PS-2(c) dated 05.05.2020. He prayed that instant O.A. has no substance and is liable to be dismissed.

5. We have heard learned counsel of both the parties.

6. Before approaching this Tribunal applicant had preferred statutory complaint as well as legal notice dated 14.12.2017 and 25.11.2018 which was replied by the respondents vide letter dated 05.02.2019, hence Original Application is maintainable.

7. The matter relates to grant of stay on discharge order during extended period of service. For adjudication of matter on interim relief, counter affidavit is necessary.

8. Respondents are directed to file counter affidavit within four weeks.
