No. 1400 of 2010. By means of this order T.A. was dismissed in default.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that delay in filing the application is not deliberate. Applicant had filed a Writ Petition being Writ Petition No.53701 of 2006 in the High Court Of Judicature At Allahabad for the grant of disability pension which after creation of Armed Forces Tribunal was transferred to this Tribunal under section 36 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 vide order dated 06.08.2010 passed by the Allahabad High Court. Thereafter notice regarding transfer of the case was sent to the applicant by the office of this Tribunal, however, applicant along with his family being not resided in his village being engaged in a private job, the said notice could not be served to him and the T.A. was dismissed in default treating notice was served to the applicant. Applicant kept asking the counsel engaged in the matter regarding progress in his case till 2015 and he was informed that the case was pending. In January 2020, applicant contacted another counsel for doing pairavi in his case, as the earlier counsel had died, who after inquiry informed that case had been transferred to the Tribunal and dismissed in default. Thus he submitted that delay in filing the application is not deliberate but for the reasons stated above which be condoned and T.A. be heard and decided on merit.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Learned counsel for the respondents, on the other hand, submitted that long delay of more than 3458 days has not been properly and sufficiently explained hence delay should not be explained.</p>

It is not disputed that there is a delay of 3458 days in filing the application which according to applicant is due to non service of notice which was sent to the applicant by the Tribunal after the case was transferred to the Tribunal from the High Court. Applicant's contention in this regard is that as after being discharged from service he along with his family was out of village in connection with a private job the notice sent by Tribunal could not be served to him and he could not appear in Tribunal on the date fixed and the case was dismissed in default. This contention of the applicant is patently false. A perusal of record shows that after the receipt of the record of the T.A. from Allahabad High Court by transfer notice of the same was sent to the applicant through registered post with acknowledgment card on the address given by him in the T.A. (Writ Petition) and the same was received by the applicant. Acknowledgement card which bears signature of the applicant has been received in the office of the Tribunal and based on that the case was dismissed in default on the date fixed that is 11.11.2010. The AD is available on record and it shows that notice was received to the applicant on 27.09.2010. It completely falsifies the case taken by the applicant that he being out of the village in connection with a private job notice was not received to him.

It is settled in law that in case of delay it should be explained on day to day basis whereas in the present case the reason assigned for condonation of delay is patently false which renders the application in allowable.

In view of the above, delay in filing the application is not condonable and, therefore, the same is **rejected**.

Recall application being time barred is also **rejected**.

Counsel for the respondents, on the other hand, submits that he has no objection with regard to recall of the order dated 11.11.2022 as, admittedly, the same has been passed in absence of the Ld. Counsel for the applicant.
