Counsel for the applicants – Union of India &amp; Others.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">This application has been filed under Section 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 against the judgment and order dated 26.08.2021 of this Tribunal in Original Application No. 292 of 2020.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">There is a delay of 09 months and 18 days in filing of leave to appeal.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Submission of Ld. Counsel for the applicants – Union of India &amp; Others is that delay in filing leave to appeal is not deliberate. His further submission is that after receiving the judgment from AFT Legal Cell, it was sent to OIC Records, Bihar Regiment and Chief of the Army Staff for obtaining legal opinion for the compliance of Tribunal's order dated 21.03.2022 and after receiving legal opinion, higher authorities given instruction to grant the certificate of Leave to Appeal. Thus, his submission is that delay is not deliberate, but for the reasons stated above.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Having heard the submission of Ld. Counsel for the applicants – Union of India &amp; others and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we find that explanation offered by the applicants for delay in filing Leave to Appeal is not sufficient.
