Counsel for the respondents is present.</p> <p>Shri Pankaj Upadhyay, IDAS, Additional Controller of Defence Accounts, Office of Principal Controller of Defence Accounts (Central Command), Lucknow is also present.</p> <p>This is an application for implementation of order dated 18.01.2021 in Original Application No. 202 of 2019, by which, the respondents have been directed to grant disability pension to the applicant @20% for two years with a further direction to hold Re-Survey Medical Board to assess further disability of the applicant, if any. It has also been directed to comply the order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, or else default will invite interest @8% per annum till the actual payment.</p> <p>When the order was not complied within the given time, Execution Application was filed wherein on 09.12.2022 it was stated from the side of the respondents that PS Directorate has concurred for the implementation of the order and file was sent to Principal Integrated Financial Advisor, Army Headquarters, New Delhi for financial concurrence, but the same has not been received yet. It was also stated that case file is lying with the office of Principal Integrated Financial Advisor, Army Headquarters, New Delhi since 07.12.2022.</p> <p>Based on the above submissions, respondents were directed to make compliance of the order within four weeks, or else the Principal</p>

Integrated Financial Advisor, Army Headquarters, New Delhi will remain physically present in Tribunal on the next date fixed i.e. 20.01.2023 to explain the reason of non-compliance of the order.

In compliance of the above, Shri Pankaj Upadhyay, Additional Controller of Defence Accounts, Office of Principal Controller of Defence Accounts (Central Command), Lucknow is present and he produced a copy of letter dated 17.01.2023 issued by Senior Deputy Integrated Financial Advisor (Q&M) to the Principal Controller of Defence Accounts (Central Command) (Legal Cell), Lucknow which is taken on record.

In the letter it has been stated that Tribunal has erred in law in allowing Original Application for the grant of disability pension instead of disability element. It has been further stated that in view of the fact that applicant was not invalided out from service on medical ground but was discharged from service on his own request in low medical category, he is entitled to disability element only and not the disability pension as stated in the order.

It has been further stated in the letter that :-

- (i) MA may be filed in the instant case for getting clarification from AFT regarding disability element as the applicant is entitled for the disability element only.
- (ii) If, as per AFT, it is a case of Disability Pension, then the case may be referred to MoD as the case is beyond the purview of the delegated powers in terms of MoD letter No. 6176/2015-D (CMU) dated 03.04.2017.

It has been further stated in the letter that Principal Integrated Financial Advisor function is in advisory role to the CFA and this office only recommends the case to the CFA in a very professional manner with due diligence of latest rules/judgments. CFA can overrule the advice of Principal Integrated Financial Advisor or go to hither advisory authority i.e. MoD for decision. It may be noted that 'CFA' for the case is Army Authority i.e. AG only, if appeal is not contemplated. In the opinion of this office, in the absence of requisite clarification on the AFT order, a considered decision to implement or appeal cannot be made.

From the above, it appears that Principal Integrated Financial Advisor is sitting over the order passed by this Tribunal as a Court of Appeal and analysing the merit of the order by exercising a jurisdiction vested in a Court of Appeal. The act of the Principal Integrated Financial Advisor comes within the purview of contempt of the order of the

Tribunal. In the event any order is passed by any Court or Tribunal, the authority to whom the order is directed has limited options, i.e. (i) either to comply the order or (ii) prefer Appeal against the order but cannot analyse legality of the order. It is relevant to mention that the order to be implemented is dated 18.01.2021 and it was to be implemented within four months from the date of production of certified copy of the order. Despite more than two years being elapsed, the same has not yet been complied rather it is being questioned saying Tribunal has erred in passing the order without preferring any Appeal. Since the act of not implementing the order by questioning its legality after a lapse of two years is nothing but a wilful disobedience of the order, we think proper to direct the registry of this Tribunal to issue notice to the Principal Integrated Financial Advisor, Army Headquarters, New Delhi to appear in person in this Tribunal on the next date fixed to file reply why contempt proceedings be not initiated against her.

Accordingly, registry is directed to issue notice to the Principal Integrated Financial Advisor, Army Headquarters, New Delhi to appear in person in this Tribunal on the next date fixed to file reply why contempt proceedings be not initiated against her.
