Counsel for the applicant and Ms. Appoli Srivastava, Ld. Counsel for the respondents.</p> <p style="text-align: justify;">The applicant has filed this application for setting aside the outcome of General Court Martial Proceedings initiated against the applicant by which the order of severe reprimand has been passed against him.</p> <p style="text-align: justify;">A preliminary objection has been raised by the respondents regarding maintainability of the O.A. inter alia on the ground that Original Application filed against the order of Severe Reprimand in Court Martial Proceedings is not maintainable in view of Section 3 (o) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007. For this, reliance has been placed on the judgment of Armed Forces Tribunal Principal Bench, new Delhi in <b><i>Original Application No 665 of 2020, Dfr Shatrughan Singh Tomar Vs. Union of India and Others</i></b>, decided on 07.04.2021 wherein it has been held that order of severe reprimand passed in Summary Court Martial being not included in definition of service matters as provided in Section 3 (o) of the AFT Act, 2007 application against it is not maintainable in AFT.</p> <p style="text-align: justify;">We have gone through the provisions laid down in Section 3 (o) of AFT Act, 2007, and also the order of Armed Forces Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi stated above and are of the view that order of severe reprimand passed in Summary Court Martial does not fall in purview of service matters defined under Section 3 (o) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007.
