However, it is borne out from the record produced by the learned counsel for the respondents that PPOs were sent to Union Bank of India, Azamgarh with regard to Hon.Nb/Sub Satya Narain Singh and Hon. Nb/Sub Bikram Ram and not to the State Bank of India Bhagauti Katra, Azamgarh City Branch, Azamgarh (UP)</p> <p>Shri Ajay Kumar Singh, Branch Manager, State Bank of India, Newada Branch, Azamgarh is present in Court. He states that he received the copies of the PPOs through the Records Office vide letter dated 17th of November 2-016, though learned counsel for the respondents submits that it was sent to Records Office in May 2016. How the delay has been caused is not borne out from the materials placed by the parties.</p> <p>Accordingly, let an affidavit be filed by the Branch Manager, State Bank of India, Newada Branch, Azamgarh indicating therein as to when he had received the copy of the PPOs for payment of pensionary benefits to the above applicants. The respondents shall also file an affidavit mentioning therein as to when the authorities concerned had sent the PPO to the respective Bank i.e. State Bank of India, Newada Branch, Azamgarh.</p>

Let a notice be issued to the State Bank of India, Newada Branch, Azamgarh to inform the Tribunal as to why the pension has not been released to Hon.Nb/Sub Satya Narain Singh and Hon. Nb/Sub Bikram Ram inspite of the fact that PPOs had been sent to it long back i.e. in the month of May 2016. While filing the affidavit, the respondent shall also indicate as to when the PPOs were sent to the respective Banks.

Subject to filing of affidavit, the personal appearance of Shri Ajay Kumar Singh, Branch Manager, State Bank of India, Newada Branch, Azamgarh is exempted till further orders.
