Since Lt Gen A.M.Verma, Member (A) has retired, this matter has come up before us for orders.</p> <p>Heard learned counsel for the parties.</p> <p>We have gone through the judgment and order dated 1.3.2014. The matter pertained to GCM proceedings and the punishment awarded to applicant Manoj Kumar, which were challenged by filing O.A. No. 269 of 2014. This Court, while holding the applicant guilty of the charges for which he was found guilty, quashed the punishment of dismissal from service awarded to him by the revision GCM and directed that the applicant be held to have been discharged from service on 15.11.2008 and to that extent the O.A was partly allowed. This Court further held the applicant eligible for pension with effect from 15.11.2008 and directed that the arrears of pension should be paid to him within a period of three months from the date of the order</p>

i.e. 1.3.2016. Now, this application has been moved by the respondents, stating that the sentence awarded to the applicant in GCM proceedings was promulgated on 13.09.2008 and not on 15.09.2008 or 15.11.2008, the dates which have wrongly typed in the aforesaid judgment and order.

Shri Shailendra Kumar Singh, learned counsel for the applicant fairly concedes and admits that the sentence aforesaid was promulgated on 13.09.2008, but submits that since this Court has mentioned the date of promulgation as 15.09.2008 in its judgment and order dated 1.3.2016, it be taken as the date of promulgation of the sentence and the respondents be directed to implement the aforesaid judgment and order from the said date.

We are not satisfied with the submission made by Shri Shailendra Kumar Singh. When a factual aspect has been brought to the notice of this Court showing that the sentence was promulgated on 13.09.2008, it is clear that the date of promulgation of sentence was incorrectly mentioned as 15.09.2008, which, being a typographical error in the judgment, need be corrected.

Accordingly, the application is allowed. The date of promulgation of sentence mentioned as 15.09.2008 in the aforesaid judgment and order be read as 13.09.2008. The judgment and order dated 1.3.2016 shall stand corrected to the above extent.

While concluding the above observation for correction in the aforesaid judgment, we also direct that the respondents shall implement the same expeditiously, say within a period of one month from today.
