Thus, the order under execution has already been complied with and there</p>

remains nothing for compliance by the respondents. As it comes out from the order Annexure-3, since the applicant has again deserted with effect from 12.12.2015, the said order dated 13.12.2015 has been passed and it being a fresh cause of action has nothing to do with the order under execution.

Accordingly, this execution application being misconceived is hereby dismissed.
