Counsel for the applicant that the applicant was enrolled in Indian Army on 23.10.1983. He was discharged from Army after serving more than 15 years and was re-enrolled in DSC on 28.09.2002. Applicant was discharged from service after completing more than 17 years of DSC Service. Release Medical Board was conducted on 05.08.2019 but the copy of the medical board was not granted to him.9. Ld. counsel for the applicant further submitted that the applicant has preferred a representation dated 10.05.2023 (Annexure A-1) for providing the copy of the Medical Board and also grant of disability pension which has not yet been responded by the respondents and is still pending.

10. Applicant's counsel submitted that the instant O.A. may be disposed of as the applicant is only seeking decision on the representation preferred by him and ends of justice would be served if a direction is given by this Tribunal to the respondents/competent authority to consider and dispose of the pending representation dated 10.05.2023 of the applicant attached as Annexure A-1 to this O.A. which may be decided by the Respondents by way of reasoned and speaking order within a stipulated period of time.
11. Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection to this and agrees with the submission of the applicant.
12. In view of the above innocuous prayer made by the applicant, respondents/competent authority is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 10.05.2023 of the applicant (Annexure A-1) and pass a reasoned and speaking order according to law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, under intimation forthwith to the applicant.
13. It is made clear that nothing has been commented upon the merits of the case.
14. Applicant shall be at liberty to approach proper forum if he is not satisfied with the decision of the respondents passed on his representation.
15. The OA is disposed of accordingly.
