	off.

6. This Original Application has been filed for grant of disability pension which is recurring cause of action. we find that the cause shown for the delay and maintainability is sufficient. Further being pensionary matter and in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex court in the case of *Union of India and others Versus Tarsem Singh* [2008 (8) SCC 648], delay is condoned. Delay condonation application stands **disposed off** accordingly.
